The DeSoto girls basketball team picked up right where they left off before the holiday break. The Bulldogs extended their winning streak to 4 with a 59-38 win over the Imagine Lady Sharks.

The first meeting was a mirror image of the latest contest. In the first contest, just 3 weeks earlier, the Bulldogs won 60-35. They led at the half 39-13 in the first meeting and had a 35-14 edge in the rematch.

Zeri "Butta" Tyler scored the other 4 first quarter points and both players led the team in scoring with 17 points each. Tyler also had a good night defensively as she blocked two first quarter shots which forced the Sharks to alter their shooting angles for the rest of the game.

"We have to work with Lazaiya on that three point shot, she should have had a couple of extra points if


was a warm welcoming person, loved to sing and laugh. Odie was an active Christian, she studied the bible, and was generous of herself and participated in charitable endeavors.



CROISSANT BREAD PUDDING

- 4 large croissants (about 3 ounces each)
- 1 red baking apple, such as Jonathan
- 6 eggs
- 1/2 cup plus 3 tablespoons sugar, divided
- 2 cups half and half
- 1 orange

- 1/2 cup pecan halves, chopped
- 3/4 cup butterscotch caramel ice cream topping
- 1/4 teaspoon rum extract
- 1/2 cup golden raisins
- Preheat oven to 350 F. Lightly spray a deep baking dish with nonstick cooking spray. Slice croissants from
 top to bottom into 1/2-inch slices. Set aside 16 of the largest slices. Cube remaining slices and place
 in bottom of baker. Arrange reserved slices over cubes in an overlapping circular pattern. Core and slice
 apple, leaving peel on; cut slices in half. Tuck apple slices between croissant slices.
- In a bowl, whisk eggs and 1/2 cup of the sugar. Pour half and half into a microwave-safe container and microwave on high 2 minutes or until hot. Slowly add half and half to egg mixture; whisk until blended. Carefully pour egg mixture over croissants. If necessary, lightly press croissants down to coat.
- 3. Zest orange to measure 2 teaspoons zest. Juice orange to measure 1/4 cup juice; set juice aside. Chop pecans. Combine remaining sugar, orange zest and pecans; sprinkle over croissants. Bake 30 to 35 minutes or until golden brown and set in center. Remove from oven to a cooling rack; let stand 10 minutes.
- 4. Meanwhile, combine ice cream topping, rum extract, reserved orange juice, and raisins in a microwave-safe container. Microwave on high 30 to 60 seconds or until hot; pour into serving bowl. Serve sauce over pudding.
