<p>ITEM 5</p> <p style="text-align: center;">APPLICATION AND DEFINITIONS</p> <p>Switching charges named (unless otherwise specified) will apply for handling loaded cars one-way and empty the other. If cars move empty in both directions charges for one-way movement will apply. If cars are moved empty one-way and are returned, they will be charged as if loaded and switching of other cars loaded will not be considered as offsetting one-way movement of empty cars.</p> <p style="text-align: center;">DEFINITIONS</p> <p>The terms shown below, as used in this tariff, are defined as follows:</p> <p>INITIAL PLACEMENT (PACT): A switch movement to/from the GU rail yard to a customer for unloading or loading of railcars. Railcar movement consists of one empty move and one loaded move.</p> <p>INTRA-PLANT SWITCHING: A switching movement from one point to another point within the trackage limits of the same plant or industry after initial placement of rail car to customer.</p>	<p>ITEM 130</p> <p style="text-align: center;">CARS FURNISHED AND RELEASED EMPTY</p> <p>Whenever empty cars are ordered but not used in transportation services, a charge of \$250.00 per car will be assessed. The charge is to be collected from the party who orders the car and will be additional to all other applicable charges.</p>
	<p>ITEM 135</p> <p style="text-align: center;">SWITCHING SERVICES REQUIRING SPECIAL HANDLING AND OR CREW AND LOCOMITVE</p> <p>For special handling use of locomotive and crew requested by customer the charge will be... \$475 per hour billed in 1/2hour increments with a minimum 4 hour charge.</p>
	<p>ITEM 140</p> <p style="text-align: center;">DEMMURAGE</p> <p>Cars not unloaded within the allotted two (2) free days will be assessed a daily storage charge per car per day. Cars will be considered placed (or constructively place upon customer notification) at customer at 12:01 AM day of placement and the two (2) free days will begin at 12:01am on day of placement. The Following charges will apply after the two (2) free days have expired:</p> <p>Railroad Controlled Cars: \$85.00 for each of the first six days; \$115.00 for each of the subsequent days</p> <p>Industry controlled private car.....\$55 per day Mechanical Refrigerated cars.....\$175 per day</p> <p>Empty Railcars Formerly Containing Hazardous Materials or Explosives.....\$150 per day</p>
<p>ITEM 100</p> <p style="text-align: center;">CARS RELEASED PRIOR TO UNLOADING</p> <p>Cars released by industry without being completely unloaded will be returned to industry to complete unloading subject to a charge of..... \$160.00 per car/per day.</p>	
<p>ITEM 105</p> <p style="text-align: center;">HOLD FOR BILLING</p> <p>For railcar loaded, pulled from customer track, and held within the GU Rail yard for outbound billing.....\$50 per car/per day</p>	
<p>ITEM 110</p> <p style="text-align: center;">INTRA PLANT SWITCHING</p> <p>After initial placement of railcar to customer, the charge for moving cars within the customer facility will be charged\$160.00 per car.</p>	
<p>ITEM 115</p> <p style="text-align: center;">MIS-ROUTED CARS</p> <p>Cars handled by GU for customers not located on the GU are subject to..... \$500 handling charge.</p>	
<p>ITEM 120</p> <p style="text-align: center;">CHARGES FOR WEIGHING OR REWEIGHING CARLOAD SHIPMENTS</p> <p>When GU is requested to weigh carload shipments, the charges will be.....N/A per car.</p>	
	<p>ITEM 145</p> <p style="text-align: center;">PRIVATE RAILCAR STORAGE</p> <p>For long –term storage (30 days or more) of empty non revenue privately owned railcars the following charges will apply:</p> <p>Movement of Railcars from Interchange to Storage Track and reverse: Inbound Charge.....\$150.00 per car Outbound Charge.....\$150.00 per car Per Car Order (Pull from line).....\$175.00 p/c plus Outbound Pick Pull (not from line).....\$250 p/c plus Outbound</p> <p>Per Day Storage Fee (Non-Hazardous Materials)..... \$ 4.00</p>
	<p>ITEM 150</p> <p style="text-align: center;">SIDE TRACK MAINTENANCE</p> <p>The charge for maintaining each industrial switch connection is \$2,667 per year. This charge is payable by the owner for the sidetrack served by the industrial switch connection within thirty (30) days of invoice date and for each succeeding year.</p> <p>The charge will not apply where specific terms of an executed Sidetrack Agreement so provide.</p> <p>GU is under no obligation to provide service to or from those private sidetracks for which any part of the applicable charge is unpaid.</p>
