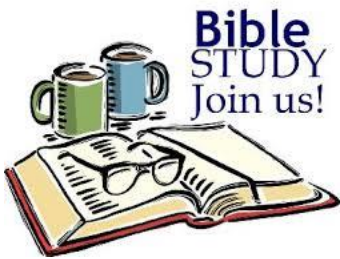


Bible Challenge
