Welcoming Rev. Lennox Scarlett!



On Sunday, January 4, 2026, Stoney Creek and Pioneer Memorial United Churches welcomed our new minister, Rev Lennox Scarlett. Reverend Scarlett comes to us with twenty-nine years of ministry experience in Jamaica and Canada. He has a degree in Theology and Diploma in Ministerial Formation from the United Theological College of the West Indies and University of the West Indies. He also has a Masters Degree in Practical Theology from the Theologische Universiteit, Kampen, the Netherlands.

He has worked at Churches in Jamaica and also a School Chaplain at a Boarding School. He came to Canada in 2018 and his first Church was Scotland United. While serving there the Church merged with Oakland United. His most recent church was Wesley United in Welland. While there he worked to engage with local organizations and schools. He also established a food pantry.

Reverend Scarlett has also been the president of Regional Council and is Commissioner to the General Council of the United Church of Canada. He is also a board member of Brock University Ecumenical Chaplaincy.

The Joint Search Committee was most impressed with his spirituality and passion for pastoral care and outreach.

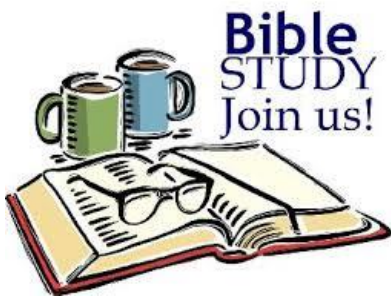
Following the worship service, we had a "Meet and Greet" Coffee Hour, giving everyone the opportunity to say "welcome"
