



## USM44C Regional Coordinator Key Responsibilities and Benefits

- **Promote Memoir '44 Locally to Recruit and Teach New Players**
  - Conduct instructive demos to introduce the game, teach rules and strategies, and share its enjoyment with new players.
  - Organize and run regular casual gaming sessions (e.g., play dates or demo days, overlords) to spark interest and build local participation (at least 4-6 times annually).
  - Promote all regional events on the USM44C Facebook page.
  - Photograph events and post updates/photos about them on the USM44C Facebook page.
- **Organize Regional Tournaments and Events**
  - Host 1-day tournaments, epic game days (e.g., large-scale Overlord maps), or other fun events to engage both new and experienced players.
  - Build toward holding tournaments or major events once or twice a year.
- **Funnel Players to the National Championship**
  - Through regional tournaments, identify and qualify **one champion per region**, who earns free entry to the annual US Open National Tournament.
- **Community Building**
  - Lead efforts to grow the regional player base and foster a thriving local community.
  - Align activities with local gaming clubs, board game stores, or hobby shops.
- **Seed Donation**
  - Consider donating a yearly amount of **\$25** to USM44C. (Donations support the website and the US Open.)
