ex: teacher, advisor, counselor, employer, minister, community service supervisor
- ☐ Include **handwritten letter** (*on lined paper*), by the applicant. In your letter, share a meaningful incident or moment- inside or outside the arena – while participating at District 3 that had a deep impact on you. Be honest and thoughtful; this is your chance to let the committee get to know you beyond your achievements.
- ☐ All applicants will have a mandatory personal interview with District 3 Scholarship Committee. The committee will contact you with a, time and location.
