Include handwritten letter (on lined paper), by the applicant. In your letter, share a meaningful
incident or moment- inside or outside the arena – while participating at District 3 that had a deep
impact on you. Be honest and thoughtful; this is your chance to let the committee get to know you
beyond your achievements.
All applicants will have a mandatory personal interview with District 3 Scholarship Committee.
The committee will contact you with a time and location.

Mailing Instructions

Please do NOT require a signature for delivery, as this may cause delays. If you would like to track your application, we recommend using USPS with delivery receipt only.

Redemption Process

You will have up to 2 years to collect your scholarship. Once you are enrolled in a college or vocational course and have paid your fees, you will need to wait until after the "drop date" or class withdrawal date has passed. Then, obtain an official letter from your school confirming your enrollment as a student.
