

Apparel Expectations

Proper show apparel must be worn. The following are general recommendations for showing. It will ultimately be up to your trainer's discretion. Sometimes children under the age of 12 will be asked to show in tall boots and hairnets, and vice-versa.

For riders under the age of 12:

- show short (white)
- show coat (navy, black, grey, or green)
- jodphurs (tan)
- belt
- garter straps (brown)
- paddock boots (brown)
- gloves (brown, black, or navy)
- helmet (black or brown)
- bows (X2, hair typically in low pigtail braids)
- crop (black or brown)

For riders over the age of 12:

- show short (white)
- show coat (navy, black, or green)
- breeches (tan)
- belt
- tall boots (black)
- gloves (black, or navy)
- helmet (black)
- hair net (matching the color of the rider's hair)
- crop (black)
