It is hard to believe that summer is finally here! Our end of the school year program and graduation ceremony was held on Friday, May 31st. Congratulations to all our graduates and many thanks to our teachers for the amazing program. Many thanks to all that helped with the set up and brought food and treats for the reception.

Plutarchos Academy students participated in the Greektown 2024 Public Art Project "The Owl of Athena". It was such an amazing opportunity to study Mythology, History and Poetry and create wonderful art at the same time.

We painted a tall statue of an owl. Our statue was given the title: «Γνωθι σαυτόν». In Greek mythology, a little owl (Athene noctua) represents or accompanies Athena, the goddess of wisdom. Due to this association, the owl came to represent intelligence, knowledge and wisdom. Athens was a prominent ancient Greece city, the center of classical culture and a great military power. In classical times, the owl was the emblem of the city of Athens and the goddess Athena was the city's patron deity. Ancient coins ((tetradrachms) from this time featured the head of Athena on one side and an owl on the other. Metmuseum.org.

The owl embodies wisdom, truth and the pursuit of education. Parallel to the symbolism of the owl is the old philosophical maxim, "Γνωθι σαυτόν" or "Know Thyself". First thought to have been spoken by Sophocles, many Hellenic philosophers and later Church leaders specifically the Three Hierarchs, have referred to "Γνωθι σαυτόν" as the ultimate goal of a persons journey to Wisdom, Truth, Knowledge and Theosis. Know Thyself is the study of oneself, the cultivation of oneself, the expression of will for the greater good and the understanding that human life goes beyond the physical and temporary.

Our teachers were invited to the ribbon cutting ceremony on Wednesday, June 5th and gave a small presentation. It is so rewarding to see our hard work and talent getting recognized! A heartfelt thank you to Mrs. Fay Feradouros for her leadership and guidance during this art project. Her passion and dedication have truly inspired all of our students.

Our Camp Kalokairaki will be held the week of June 17th. Please register your kids as soon as possible.

We would like to remind our families that the Ellinopoula accounts are staying active until the end of the summer. Check out some of the new collections like, Father's Day, where kids learn about family relationships in Greek, or Space Travel, where kids become astronauts, step on board the spaceship "Argo," and learn about the solar system while traveling in space.

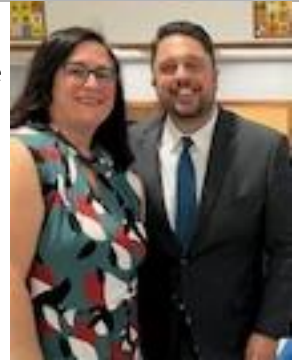
FLOGA DANCE TROUPE
