Memorial Scholarship

The Memorial Scholarship Committee of St. Spyridon, Palos Heights offers a scholarship to a college undergraduate or graduate student who has completed a minimum of one year in their respective major in an accredited college or university and who is a steward of our parish. This is a competitive scholarship based on the criteria outlined below.

2022 Memorial Scholarships Available

Charles C. Condes Memorial Scholarship - \$2,000

Requirements are the following:

- Currently enrolled college students with 1 year (2 semesters) completed are eligible to apply.
- Applicant must be a son/daughter of a steward of St. Spyridon Hellenic Orthodox Church.
- A copy of college transcript with school's official seal that illustrates one-year completion.
- Essay and Formal Resume
- References (minimum one of the below options):
 - the **first** from a teacher or professor, advisor, counselor, or dean.
 - the **second** personal or business reference that is a non-family member.
 - Letters of recommendation must be on school or business letterhead.

APPLICATION & ALL REQUIRED DOCUMENTS MUST BE SUBMITTED AND SIGNED ELECTRONICALLY ON OR BY JULY 15TH, 2022 TO OFFICE@SAINT-SPYRIDON.NET.

Incomplete applications or those postmarked after this date will not be processed. All information received from applicants will be treated as confidential.

After a review of a candidate's application and equal consideration of eligibility requirements, the winner will be selected upon a recommendation of an independent anonymous an Scholarship Committee.

Scholarship will be awarded on August 21st, 2022, following the Divine Liturgy.
