FATHER'S LETTER

Beloved Parish Family,

No other Christian denomination can compare to the ancient, consistent, yet timeless worship that Orthodox Christianity offers us throughout the year. I remember bringing a non-Orthodox friend to experience Holy Thursday evening's reading of the twelve gospels and procession with the cross. She left that evening touched with tears rolling down her face.

I have many Orthodox friends who have never been to church in between Palm Sunday and Pascha. The reward of the journey, the glory of the Resurrection, is found in the efforts put into Great Lent and Holy Week, If one has not experienced the cross and reflected upon the cross that we carry during Great Lent, then it can be difficult to truly experience the joy to be had at the Resurrection on Holy Saturday evening into Sunday morning. The readings, Old Testament and New, the hymns, the processions, the incense, the richness of our worship.

From themes of humility and preparation in the bridegroom services and the washing of the disciples' feet to the healing we continue to seek through the mystery of Holy Unction to our Lord's Passion, we experience that which happened almost 2,000 years ago in Jerusalem. We feel the darkness and fear, we make the midnight journey with the myrrh-bearing women to the tomb and we return to proclaim to the world that "Christ is Risen!"

It is my prayer that we will do our best to not just come and get the "souvenirs" – not just come to "get my palm branch" on Palm Sunday or "get the oil" on Holy Wednesday or "get the flower" on Holy Friday. These are indeed beautiful things, but when we take the substance out of what these things mean, they can almost become meaningless symbols that make us "feel good."

But if we look at Holy Week and understand that it is a time for renewal – and we share this opportunity with our entire parish family – we can be enthused to be an active participant of what Christ offers us each and every day of Holy Week.

Holy Week provides us with the opportunity to be anointed for the healing of our soul and body. Holy Thursday is an opportunity to kneel before the Cross of Christ and leave anger and disappointment at His feet. The flowers we receive Holy Friday evening are to be symbolic of the pruning we have done to our soul throughout Lent and Holy Week so that we can blossom into the beauty God has always intended for you and me. In nine days, there are eight opportunities to come and receive Holy Communion. We are to be always ready to receive Christ and prepared ultimately for His second coming.

Therefore, make a plan for this year's Holy Week to be different. Plan and invest more time than the previous year to pray communally and attend more services than the previous year (there are seventeen services offered during Holy Week including Saturday of Lazaros). Open your heart and soul to the substance of what each day and material object truly is, and you will indeed have one of the most meaningful experiences of your life. May our Journey to Pascha bring each of us spiritual comfort, refreshment, renewal so that we may experience our resurrection along with our Lord's Holy Resurrection.

A Blessed Anastasi to all!





FOOD PANTRY

St. Spyridon Community in Conjunction with Project Hope

We had an extremely successful baby food and baby formula drive. We exceeded what we collected in food donations along with exceeding in monetary donations. Here is the breakdown of what was donated:

Baby Formula = 86 containers (12 more than last year)

Baby Cereal = 42 containers/boxes (1 less than last year)

Baby Food (jars and pouches) = 633 (267 more than last year)

Baby Snacks and Teething Crackers = 33 packs (10 more packs than last year)

The St. Spyridon outreach team packed everything up and took it to the Courage Program in Oak Lawn. The Courage Program is and incredible program lead by loving people who are there to help parents get what they need for their small children. On March 21st we prepared and distributed 120 lunches to the Feed the Hungry at the Cathedral and another 50 lunches for the homeless under the bridges at 18th Street, Wilson and Lawrence. Thank you to all our ladies who helped serve and delivered the lunches.



We also hosted the "Koulouma"; it was wonderful to be together in fellowship to begin our Lenten journey. On March 28th Philoptochos hosted the dinner for all attending the Great Compline Service for the South Side Clergy and on March 29th Philoptochos hosted the followship dinner after the Pre-Sanctified service. Thank you, ladies, for preparing the meals and serving our community and guests, fellowship is important to the identity of our St Spyridon community.

Our Lenten Grab and Go was not as successful as we had hoped, as our laganes missed the mark; but the taramosalata was delicious. We appreciate how everyone has been patient, kind and understanding but rest assured we will be improving our recipe for next year. So even the best of the cooks sometimes have cooking errors- keeps us humble. The good news is thanks to our communities support we will be donating approximately \$600 from this fundraiser to the UIC Children's Hospital.

On March 19th, the Sunday of the Holy Cross we hosted our traditional Loukoumades Sale. A portion of our proceeds from the sale and direct donations made by our parishioners will be given to the National Philoptochos Fund for humanitarian aid to the earthquake victims of Syria and Turkey. The response from our parishioners was strong and we are donating \$1,000 to help the victims. Once again, I thank each of you for your support and generosity as we reach out to help those in need. Our ladies say to Dina "Georgia comes to you because you never say no to her"-which is true. Another special birthday celebrated was for our eldest active member in Philoptochos, Harriet Bohac celebrating 102 years. Several of our ladies visited to celebrate with her and her daughter Eleni, with balloons, cake and birthday wishes. Last year Harriet and her family shared Mother's Day with us, where we honored her decades long of ongoing support for Philoptochos and our community. 
