



FATHER'S LETTER

"Happy New Year" is the way we greet each other this time of year. We have a new year which offers the potential for new things that are different from the previous year. Yes, the same mundane things will happen in the year to come. Household chores and work will take place. We will experience the same months and seasons.

But we yearn for newness in our life. Our soul yearns for something new. What could this newness be?

"There will be a new heaven and a new earth," says the Lord (2 Peter 3:13). A world in all its glory will become new at the end of the physical world when the Lord comes again. The bandaged and wounded person, the tree frozen for the winter, or the house under renovation, will all appear healed and healthy in time. The renovation will be complete, the wounds will be healed, and the tree will once again grow. All will be renewed to their original beauty!

But in the meantime, we have to be intentional about making things new in the New Year. There are four things one can do that are so powerful, so revolutionary, that if you implement just one of them, they will change your life and help make the New Year truly be a year of newness!

- 1) **Pray**: The bible tells us to pray without ceasing. This is something that we can all improve both individually and communally. Set aside some time every day to speak with God in prayer. Perhaps you may want to pray as the ancient Christians did at a specific hour (or hours) of the day.
- 2) **Read the Scriptures and the Holy Fathers**: Part of your prayer rule can involve some biblical reading and/or reading the life of a Saint or Father of the church.
- 3) **Avoid Sin, Cultivate the Virtues**: Set a time to schedule a confession so that you can work on your spiritual struggles. As we fight sin, we allow room for the birth and growth of virtue.
- **4) Serve and Offer Outreach:** Get involved in an outreach or philanthropic initiative/organization such a food drive, the Philoptochos, or other outreach initiative like Feed My Starving Children.
- **5) Attend Divine Liturgy Regularly:** Within worship, we have the blessing of hearing His word through the gospel readings and also through sermons. Most importantly, we are given the opportunity to experience the sacrament of Holy Communion in which our Lord is made manifest.

These may sound like New Year resolutions; however, these resolutions are what shape us and quench our thirst for the newness to come! Therefore, we "put off the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts, and put on the new man, which after God is created in righteousness and holiness (Eph. 4:22, 24). This New Year, become new within yourself. May the Lord God grant this to all!


