We were saddened to learn that Herb Jebb, better known as Metalflake, passed away on March 4th. Herb was a long-standing member of Chapter FL2-0 and has been attending our Gatherings since the early 80's. He was very knowledgeable about all things having to do with motorcycles, so for most of his tenure, Metalflake served as our Tech Support person.



At our monthly Gathering, he shared an interesting, technical piece of information that would educate us and help us be safe riders. He also entertained us with several hilarious and sometimes a little suggestive jokes! He would wear a vest displaying lots of '100,000 miles' patches, attesting to his love of motorcycle riding and his long-time rider status. It was clear that Metalflake had accumulated a huge amount of mileage over the years. In fact, he rode his motorcycle everywhere he went including to the Gathering. Every second Wed. of the month, we could count on it like clockwork; there was Metalflake proudly riding on his shimmering and shiny, metal flake painted Goldwing.... thus he acquired the nickname.

He rode and had both Honda and Triumph motorcycles, but most recently he rode a white Goldwing trike. He attended Rallies for both brand bikes and had been known to enter into ride competitions. Many have seen Metalflake at the Dania Beach Motor Cycle Rally where he competed in the 'slow bike ride' competition and won most every time. Over the years, we learned that anyone who rode in a bike group knew Herb. He was always riding somewhere and was a regular at Scooter's Restaurant in Hobe Sound every Friday night. Like in the TV series, Cheers, everyone knew his name! Herb Jebb, affectionately known as Metalflake, was a true biker and he will be missed. May you rest in peace, dear friend!





SHOP TIP

WHATS GOING ON WITH MY SCREWDRIVERS?

Do you have screwdrivers with cruddy handles? What's going on with some craftsman screwdrivers that I haven't used in a long time? A kind of white crud that stinks has formed on them and it won't come off very easy. Two years ago, when this happened, I decided to take a wire brush clean the handles then scrape them with a knife to get the remaining crud off and seal them with a clear coat spray paint. It turned out to be a labor-intensive chore and after getting as much off as I could and thinking this would be good enough that's what I did. This lasted about two years. These screwdrivers are sitting in my toolbox and haven't been used in a while since I have many duplicates and recently, I noticed they are all covered with the crud again! Am I the only one having this problem, can't be. With a little research on YouTube this is the consensus of various ideas and opinions I read. One person claimed The plastic used in the handles was acetate muterate and that the crud is the result of decomposing



plastic caused by some kind of bacteria eating the cellulose in the plastic, the result was the white coating that forms on the handles and it smells. At this point I'll take his word for it. He said he did the same thing I did by scraping them with a knife and wire brush to get the surface of the handles clean and



then sprayed them with clear coat. Not wanting to

have to go through the labor-intensive cleaning chore again and after reviewing several methods used by YouTube gurus, this seems to be the least labor intensive and fastest method of cleaning and that was to soak the screwdriver handles in clear ammonia for two minutes. I decided to give it a try, but I didn't have any clear ammonia, I did have

sudsy ammonia so I figured well what the heck I'll use that. Putting the two screwdrivers shown in a jar with the shanks pointing up, I covered the handles with the sudsy ammonia. After two minutes I would swish them around just a little bit and I could see some flakes coming off the plastic. After soaking for eight minutes the red handled screwdriver was completely clean. All I had to do was wipe the crud off which I did with some paper towels. The blue handle screwdriver took much longer and I was having a problem getting it clean probably because some of the previous clear coat was still stuck on so I thought I'm going to go for broke and let it soak overnight. The next morning everything was just wiped off with a paper towel. Another person said if you want to seal them with clear coat be sure to use one for automotive use. That got me thinking well what kind did I use last time? I really don't remember but I think it was household wood or things of that nature so maybe it wasn't the best choice. After buying some automotive clear coat I noted It was lacquer and would probably do a better job. I sprayed the handles with two coats a couple minutes apart and I'm going to see how long this will last, hopefully more than two years. They turned out clean and shiny and If you have some screwdrivers that looked like mine give this a try, you'll be surprised how well the ammonia works.



BIKE-TO-BIKE COMMUNICATION

Greeting to All,

Well, our 2025 Florida District Rally is now in the history books. What a great time we had! We had 4 Group Rides that went very well. The Rides presented us with an interesting observation. Modern technology is moving faster than Riders are changing motorcycles. A Gold Wing lasts forever if well maintained. The old standby system of communication for over 20 years has been the 40 Channel CB Radio. The new Gold Wings (2018 and newer) are not coming with a CB radio. The new bikes are equipped with a blue tooth wireless communication system. A CB radio can still be purchased and installed onto the newer Gold Wings at a considerable greater expense. You used to be able to install a CB radio to a pre-2018 Gold Wing for about \$800.00. Now it will cost you about \$2,000.00 if you can find one.

When we lined up for our daily rides, we found there were now 3 different methods of communicating. CB, Cardo-Mesh, and Sena-Bluetooth systems. To summarize what we had was a Group of Motorcyclists that could no longer talk to one another. There is no quick fix for this problem. Most of our chapters have individually resolved this issue because they are aware of what type of communication system members of their Chapter have. When you go to an event such as a District Rally plan on there being 3 different methods of communicating along with the Riders that do not have a communication device at all. There was a time before CB Radios when Hand Signals were more emphasized and used. The use of CB radios has spoiled a lot of us and talking on the CB has taken the place of hand signals. With the current electronic communication issue along with the increase of new members that do not have any electronic communication, we will have to go back to more hand signal use.

You can find diagrams on the proper use of hand signals on the EWMA Website. You can find these diagrams at: ewma-world.org, Documents, Safety/Ride Coordination, 10-Minute Presentations, Hand Signals for on Bike. You could look at this individually or Chapter Directors or SRCs can print this out and talk about at a Gathering.

Because the membership of EWMA has expanded to include all Brands of Motorcycles there is a good chance some of the new members will not have any type of Electronic Communication. What type of Electronic Communication you would suggest to these members would be determined on what type of Communication your Chapter mostly uses. To ride with members with older Gold Wings, the most expensive and maybe not the most practical conventional system would be the CB System. I would like to recommend a rather inexpensive way to obtain a CB System that would work on any Motorcycle.

Sierra Electronics sells a Portable CB System Kit that can be mounted on the handlebars. It comes with a Mount, Headset and Mic and a Push-to-Talk button for the handlebar. The price for the entire kit is \$249.99. You can find this Kit by going to www.sierra-mc.com.

Whatever your Chapter decides, find a system that works best for you Chapter and discuss it with your members to insure you can maintain Safe and Enjoyable rides.

The kit comes with RAM Handlebar Mounting Accessories with necessary hardware to offer a more universal mounting solution for most applications. Also includes a Cigarette Lighter Power Cord, as well as a Direct Wire Power Cord. We recommend powering this CB radio from the tail light of your motorcycle to reduce engine noise issues.


