Gathering

Welcome: Senior Chapter Director David Morris called the Gathering to order at 7pm at the Southern Pig and Cattle Co. Restaurant on So. US 1 in Stuart on Wed., Aug. 10, 2022. MEC Terry Henderson welcomed everyone to the Gathering and introduced our guest, John Boer, who rides a 2004 Gold Wing. Terry also welcomed back Richard and Jean Menage. Greetings also went out to District Chapter Director Bill Smith, District Rider Educator Claudia Vega and Robert as well as Phil Baxter from FL2-A. David wished a Happy Birthday to Willard Hackett and said that there were no Anniversaries this month. David also announced that Jim Rich had his right knee replaced on Mon. Aug. 8 and that he was doing well. We all wished Jim a speedy recovery.

GWRRA News: David proceeded to share information that he had received during a Zoom call on Tues. Aug. 9 with District Director Bill Smith and other Chapter Directors from the District. The following facts regarding the demise of GWRRA were discussed. As we all know, the Founders of GWRRA, Paul Hildebrand and Shirley Garcia, made the announcement during Wing Ding that they were retiring and that GWRRA would officially close their doors on Dec. 31, '22. David continued and said that there are two groups that have decided to continue and form new organizations: One is Wing Riders, a for-profit organization created by the owners of J&M Headsets. They will piggy back on another group that has their Rally in Illinois. The other group is Eagle Wings Motorcycle Association created by Anita Alkire, the former CEO of GWRRA.

New Name- Eagle Wings Motorcycle Association: David continued with an explanation of what the new group would offer and how the FL District would like to make the transition into Eagle Wings as smooth as possible for all the chapters. Due to the fact that the word 'Wing' is owned by Honda, the new association had to create a name that did not identify with Gold Wing per se. The Eagle Wing founders decided that it would be appropriate to accept all brands of bikes into the Association in order to expand membership and be successful! There will be fewer regulations and a major focus on social events and rides.

Business as usual with a few upgrades:

- Annual membership dues are \$25 for an individual or \$30 for a family membership. Everyone is called a member. There is no rider or co-rider designation.
- Chapter FL2-0/Treasure Coast Wings designation will continue.
- Eagle Wings is accepting Charter Memberships. Get your membership application in early before Sept. 30th and you'll receive a low registration number. "Bragging rights."
- Discounts on annual dues available when you purchase multiple years...1, 2 or3 years.
- Chapter fee of \$75 is due on the 1st of the year & helps fund the Region and District.
- Regions are back! Region A includes 7 states: MS, AL, GA, SC, NC, FL, & TN is added.

- Chapter Officers: Chapter Director, Assistant Chapter Director, Treasurer and Safety/Ride Coordinator.
- Our Website and communication tool, GroupWorks, will continue.
- Rider Ed Program with ARC and TRC training courses will continue.
- University Courses will continue.
- March District Rally will continue on March 16-18, 2023 at the Hilton in Altamonte Springs with competitions including the Diorama, Collage, Talent Show, Costume Contest, Mascot & Chapter Challenge. There will be no Shirt or Banner contests.
- March Rally tickets may be sold as usual. The winning ticket will receive \$10,000 prize.
- Sell 1500 Rally tickets and the \$75 Annual Chapter fee is paid for by the District.
- Chapter Couple of the Year is no longer a part of the new Association.
- Volunteers are needed to man the Hospitality Room at the March Rally.
- EWMA is a not-for-profit association and no one is getting a salary.
- Rescue Plus is no longer viable. EWMA will work on getting new Insurance Coverage.
- ARL-Area Run List- is now called the Roster which displays the entire membership.
- Rick Buck has the new logo ready to place on our website and new chapter shirts.
- EWMA's new motto is "FRIENDS for FUN, SAFETY & RIDING."

FRIENDS for FUN, SAFETY & RIDING: District Chapter Director Bill Smith reiterated the fact that the FL District is one of the top Districts in the association. It has the largest number of members, the greatest participation and largest rally, so it would be a viable option to keep things going as usual if the chapters so choose. When GWRRA CEO Anita Alkire received permission from Paul Hildebrand and Shirley Garcia to start a new organization from the ground up, she got a lot of interest from the FL District and the local chapters. The name Eagle Wings Motorcycle Association was selected in order to comply with the wishes of Honda not to use the word 'Wing' which is proprietary to Honda. EWMA encourages all different bike brands to join us as long as they are like minded bikers who want to ride safely with the proper gear and adhere to the rule of no drinking while riding! We will include people who no longer ride.

EWMA BUILDING BLOCKS: Bill stipulated that we will endeavor to establish a dynamic association using the following Building Blocks as a foundation:

- Fairness to all.
- Positive communication based on the common love of riding.
- Quality. Be the best we can be and respect one another.
- Attitude. Be enthusiastic!

David called for the winning raffle ticket to be drawn and District Chapter Director Bill Smith won the cash. The meeting was adjourned. *Reminder, the next Gathering is on Wed. Sept. 21.*

RIDING IN THE RAIN

With summer here along with our rainy season sooner or later you will be riding in it. Most of us have taken Rider Ed classes and probably read articles on the subject but here are a few reminders.

For the best traction wait at least 1/2 to one hour after it starts to rain before riding. Most of the oils and other petroleum products should wash off the surface by then.

With rain come slippery roads. Even more slippery are painted surfaces like lines at crosswalks. Metal construction plates on the road covering ditches require an extra degree of caution. Increase following distances to allow for better controlled stops and emergencies and don't let people follow you too closely.

Not only is visibility reduced but do not drive through puddles which can hide potholes and debris.

As always with railroads and uneven lanes reduce speed and try to cross at as much of an angle as possible. Perpendicular would be as good as you could get.



Rider Ed & MFA Training will continue

Gold Wing Road Riders Association will have closed its doors effective July 31st, 2022.. So how will that affect our Florida District Rider Ed Training Program?

Florida District will continue Rider and MFA training. It is not going away, there may be some modifications, but we will continue to offer you training. Our current Site Liability Insurance will still be in effect until December 31st, 2022. After that we will acquire our own Liability Insurance Policy to cover training days. We will maintain the Levels Recognition Program in the same manner as it was run in the past. There is presently a supply of different Levels Patches (GWRRA) that we can obtain from Susan Huttman, as you earn them. Once the (GWRRA) supply of patches is exhausted we will have to discuss continuing the patches and pins. However, the training will continue and we strongly encourage it to keep your skills sharp.

Please continue selling raffle tickets to fund our Florida District Training Program. We are already committed to award a large amount of Grand Prize money at our upcoming Florida District Rally. The rest of our funds will pay for materials needed to run the programs. Materials include Medic First Aid breathing lungs, gloves, gauze, books, completion cards and training for our instructors. Rider training has to pay for the range rental, insurance, range cards, trailer maintenance, paint, tape measures, completion cards etc... Selling raffle tickets affords us the ability to keep having these programs without cost to our Florida members.

We ask for patience as everything is very fluid right now with the transitioning. Our District has amazing leadership and members who are very active. We truly believe we can adapt to whatever the future holds.
