Ride Safely,

It is really important to ride safely when you are alone or in a group. The safe riding course was offered several years ago and hosted by Jim and Sondra Cuff. Today we were getting our ride instructions from John DuBose and it was apparent to me and John that not everyone was listening until John called everyone's attention to the instructions he was giving. Yes, there were a lot of us there and we were busy chatting. It is very important that everyone listens carefully to Road Captain John. There were 13 bikes in the group so John broke us up into two groups and commented on the importance of keeping the formation tight.

As your default tail gunner, I was able to observe that there were vehicles moving into our group on numerous occasions. They were able to find a large hole in the formations not keeping due to motorcycles in a tight pack. Remember, having a vehicle or truck in the midst of our motorcycle group is not safe. It may cause us to miss getting thru the traffic lights as a group and running a red light in order to stay together.



Greetings to All,

March 16th is getting closer by the day. March 16th thru March 18th, is our Florida District Rally. We are looking forward to a great time with fun friends. We will be having on-bike riding games in the parking lot for both 2-wheel and 3-wheel motorcycles. Solo or pairs riders can participate.

We will be having our \$10,000 Grand Prize Drawing at closing ceremonies. There are still some outstanding Raffle Ticket monies due from some of our Chapters. February 14th, Valentine's Day is an easy date to remember. Please send in any outstanding Chapter Raffle Ticket money by February 14th. You will still be making checks out to "GWRRA Florida District Rider Education". We will not be changing our name on our bank account to "EWMA" until after our District Rally.

YOU AND YOUR MOTORCYCLE SKILL LEVEL

It is an unfortunate fact that many motorcyclists are involved in crashes. In almost a third of them, the rider took no evasive action to avoid the crash or did so too late to avoid them. This statistic comes from a recent National Transportation Safety Board report on the causes of motorcycle crashes.

Rider education and on-road experiences stress the need for motorcyclists to pay strict attention to the road ahead and do their best to avoid dangerous situations before they occur. But motorcyclists are human, and distractions and/or a lack of riding skills can and do rear their ugly heads on occasion.

So what can be done to help a motorcyclist reduce the chances of being involved in a crash? Let's start with "The Basic Riders Course." There are many things in that course to learn other than knowing how to physically maneuver a motorcycle. Knowing how you as a human react to different situation as well as how your motorcycle will react is very helpful in saving you some grief. Many riders like me were self taught on how to ride which may have included being taught by an untrained rider. How do you know the information you are being given by that untrained person is correct? I was self taught to ride a motorcycle 28 years before I became a Motorcycle Instructor. When I went to Instructor's School I found out there were things I had been doing wrong and things I didn't know. I had a few mishaps on my bikes during my first 28 years of riding that could have been avoided had I first been given the proper instruction. I have been a MSF (Motorcycle Safety Foundation) Instructor now for 26 years which has been very beneficial to me as well as the riders I have trained.

Another thing that can help a seasoned rider is to take a one-day motorcycle refresher course. Physical skills perish with time. You might say "I ride all the time so I don't need any refresher course." The physical skills that perish over time are not the casual everyday riding skills. It is the emergency maneuvers that you don't usually get a chance to practice. It is too late to find out during an emergency that you cannot react properly. The riding skills you must stay proficient in are: Emergency Braking, Swerving and Cornering. These are the type of exercises you will practice in a one-day riding course. What better place to practice these skills than on an empty safe parking lot. It is better

to see how well you react in a simulated situation with nothing to hit, rather than to improperly react in real traffic and slam into a car.

For the older riders the benefit of taking a refresher course is self assessment. See if you can still properly handle the machine you are riding. You might find you do not still possess the physical strength to control the bike you are on. You might realize that your current bike is now too heavy to hold up during stops. You might decide to go to a lighter bike or even to a three-wheel motorcycle so you can continue to safely ride.

Two-wheel and Trike Riding Classes are available. We teach the Two-wheel and Trike one-day refresher courses. These classes will be approximately 6 hours in length depending on the amount of participants. You could also schedule a PLP (Parking Lot Practice) session. PLP's are usually only a couple of hours. You do not need a certified riding instructor to conduct a PLP. We have diagrams for the PLP exercises we would be glad to sent you upon request. We could also travel to your location for a PLP to assist you. You can utilize a parking lot of your chose as long as you have permission from the owner of the parking lot to do so. Your group could also meet us at one of our approved MSF sites for a PLP session. So consider taking a one-day refresher Riding Course or a PLP for your safety as well as the safety of the loved one riding with you.

We are here to assist you with your training needs.
