House of Hope Award

“Empowering Martin County residents to overcome hunger and hardship” is the Mission Statement of House of Hope. It is a worthy goal that House of Hope encourages everyone in the community to embrace and one that our Chapter FL2-0 has enthusiastically accepted and supported. More than two years ago,

Sandy Pisano, our Spirit Team leader suggested that we do a fund raising activity within the Chapter. Many ideas were bantered about but eventually we decided to collect and donate non-perishable food items for House of Hope. That decision has resulted in the Treasure Coast Wings gathering over 600 lbs of food and donating it to House of Hope where it is distributed to food-insecure families in our community. In order to honor us as a valued partner, House of Hope invited us to the Hope Awards Breakfast at the Monarch Country Club in Palm City on Wed. Sept. 14 at 8:30am. Sandy and Joe Pisano attended the breakfast and gracefully accepted the Hope Award on behalf of Treasure Coast Wings. House of Hope thanked our Chapter for working hand-in-hand with them to empower Martin County residents to overcome hunger and hardship. While at the breakfast, Sandy and Joe learned that “House of Hope knows that it is sometimes difficult to feed people well and that the challenge is often the availability and cost of fresh, healthy fruits and vegetables, so to overcome that obstacle they not only collect donated food from generous donors but they continue to develop and improve their Growing Hope Production Farm in Palm City.” “Last year they added an additional 30x96 ft. greenhouse bringing the total to 65,000 cubic feet of hydroponic greenhouse growing space.” They also use conventional growing techniques and have a small grove of over 60 fruit trees and berry bushes. Plus, they are building a new Packing House Facility at the farm which will “allow for efficient and proper cleaning, packaging, and storage of all produce grown at the farm, gleaned locally or donated through their range of agricultural partnerships.” “The yield at the farm is expected to top 10,000 packages of produce each month by the end of 2022.” It is their goal to distribute over 1.5 million pounds of food this year to needy neighbors through four Client Choice pantries and 35 local food bank partners. Sandy has expressed an interest in planning a ride to the Growing Hope Production Farm in Palm City where we will have an opportunity to tour the farm or main service center and learn more about House of Hope. Until that scheduled ride, we will continue to bring non-perishable food items and toiletries to our Gatherings in October and November with the express purpose of helping feed needy families at Thanksgiving. Thank you to all of our faithful and generous members who donate food throughout the year. And thank you, Sandy and Joe, for accepting our honorary Hope Award. Treasure Coast Wings is making a difference!

On average, motorcycles are about twice as fuel efficient as cars.

The first Harley Davidson motorcycle, built in 1903, used a tomato soup can for a carburetor. Did you notice that these are generic, meaning that in the above five fun facts there is only one mention of the motorcycle brand and that was only to say that their first motorcycle had a soup can as a carburetor! It doesn't matter what you ride...just that you love to ride, and ride safely of course!
