

BLUE HIGHWAYS

Blue Highways is a book about travelling the back roads in the pre-Walmart days when the maps showed the main roads in red and the secondary roads in blue. The author, William Least Heat-Moon, is a college professor at a mid-west college that closes its doors for lack of students. At age 38 he decides to outfit his Ford Econoline for travel and hit the road. The stories he tells about the small towns and the people who live there are a true reflection of rural America. There are no straight lines in his travels as he detours to look for places that no longer exist, or only exist on an historical marker. He detours to try new things, like a side trip into the bayous of south Louisiana to try real Cajun food. He takes roads that turn into gravel or dirt trails or lead into high mountains where he gets stranded overnight in a snowdrift in late May. A local points out the sign that says, "DO NOT TRAVEL IN WINTER." The author says May is not winter and the local replies "around here it is." I share this because the book reminds me of what motorcycling is all about, riding the back roads and exploring the small towns that continue to exist in rural America.

Level's Classes Available

Hello all,

Florida District Riding and MFA Classes are available upon request to maintain your Levels status. For ARC and TRC Classes contact Dominick at Dominickflde@gmail.com. For MFA Classes contact Claudia at rvega19854@gmail.com.

We conducted an ARC Class on July 27th in Ocala. Six members attended. It was hot with a "feels like temperature" of about 100. When I rode home the TPMS screen on my bike showed that the temperature of my rear tire was 116 degrees. We scheduled that class on that particular date because that was the date the members attending requested. I would prefer to conduct the outdoor riding classes in the cooler months. I think we should wait until October to resume. Currently we will be limiting the size of the Riding Classes to only 6 motorcycles, as I am the only available ARC Certified Instructor in Florida at this time. If we acquire another ARC Certified Instructor we can increase the size of the classes to as many as 12 motorcycles. The same restrictions apply to the TRC Classes.

The procedures for requesting a class will be conducted in the following manner: A Chapter Director or CSEA can survey their group to see which of their members want to take either the ARC or TRC. They should also decide on a tentative date for the class. This information is to be forwarded to me so I can check on the available of a riding site. If all is agreed upon, I would then want the CD or CSEA to collect and hold a \$30.00 deposit which is refundable upon completion of the course. If a Chapter does not have enough members to fill a class I will advertise the Class on Group Works to get enough members to fill the Class. I also take individual member requests which I will keep in a file pending enough members to fill a class.

Florida is in need of Rider Instructors for both the ARC and TRC Riding Courses. I have been teaching Riding Classes for 25 years. It has been both rewarding and fun to teach these classes. You, as an Instructor will learn invaluable safety information and riding techniques that you will pass on to your fellow GWRRA Members. If you are interested in becoming a Rider Instructor please contact me and I can advise you how to proceed. There is a GWRRA Rider Instructor Course scheduled for November 17th -20th, 2021 in Athens, AL. If you are interested please contact me as soon as possible. Space is limited and paperwork must be submitted in a timely manner to qualify.




