## Restoration Journey Update

Wow! It seems like not ago that we began our journey to reach families in our community; however, our anniversary on [March 14](#), brought home that we've been meeting needs since opening our pantry on this date in 2014. During the ensuing years, we've met numerous families, prayed with many of them for specific needs, shared the Word with them, encouraged and shared job opportunities. It seems often that the foodstuffs we are able to give out, although needed, are secondary to the relationships we've built and are continuing to build.

We've undergone several changes as the Lord has shown us that the changes need to be made. We've had a number of volunteers come, serve and move on as needs, health and family constraints arose. Our volunteers have come from not only Cordesville Baptist, but other local churches—but that is how the Church is supposed to function. Although we've had to return to our original geographic parameters, we don't turn anyone away who comes to us; however, we do share with them the available resources closer to their homes demonstrating the need for stewardship on their parts and ours. We've been blessed with our relationship with Bi-Lo (now KJ's) in that they give us their best prices for our purchases, are willing to make special orders or packaging as requested, and have made donations of gift cards and special items. The relationships we've built with them has given opportunities to share how the Lord is working and encouraging them in their personal walks.

Families hear of us primarily by word of mouth. We have an older man from our community who comes fairly regularly for food who also finds people in need and brings them with the assurance that we won't turn them away.

Toward the end of February, I shared that we had need of eggs and additional financial support. God is so awesome! Our need for eggs was answered on a [Monday](#) evening, just in time for [Tuesday's](#) families. Since then, we've had additional egg donations so we have nearly a months worth of eggs in the refrigerator and our financial needs have been met! Y'all are totally awesome with your continued support of this ministry. Thank you for your prayers, encouragement, donations of goods and financial support. Thank you for working with us to make Jesus known in our community!

Update: New Community Ministry is in the making: Making it R.E.A.L. Hot Meal

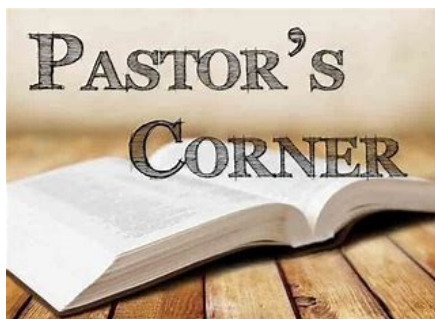
