

- A. President
- B. Vice-President
- C. Secretary
- D. Treasurer

Section 2. An officer who does not comply with assigned responsibilities may be relieved of office by a majority vote of the executive board. Appointment of a replacement shall be made by the president with the approval of the board.

Section 3. At the discretion of the executive board, committees may be formed. The heads of committees shall be appointed by the president and approved by the elected board.

Article VI - Elections

Section 1. Nominations from the floor will be in order at the February meeting.

Section 2.

- A. Election shall be by secret ballot.
- B. Voting privileges
 - 1. Active members - one vote per lot.
 - 2. Inactive members - one vote per lot.
 - 3. Voting privileges are extended only to members in good standing with dues paid.
 - 4. Those persons receiving the majority of the vote will be the new elected officers.

Section 3.

- A. Term of Office. Officers shall be elected for a term of one (1) year, to serve from the time of installation in February until the succeeding installation in February.

Section 4. Transition of Administration. There shall be a meeting of the executive board within two weeks of installation. It should include the incoming and outgoing officers. Upon the introduction of new business. All files and records are turned over to the newly installed president, who then becomes the presiding officer.

Article VII - Duties of Officers

Section 1. The president shall

- A. Preside at all meetings of the executive board and general meetings of the organization, and at any special meetings;
- B. Appoint committee heads, as necessary;
- C. Make interim appointments as needed with the approval of the executive board;
- D. Sign all checks with the treasurer;
- E. Sign all contracts with the secretary, after approval of the executive board.
- F. Serve as an ex-officio member of all committees;
- G. Call a special meeting when necessary.

Section 2. The vice-president shall perform the duties of an absent president and perform such duties as are assigned by the president.
