

Safeguarding Code of Conduct for Children and Young People

The responsibility of TassieCare staff

TassieCare staff will:

- Do our best to make sure that you are safe from harm.
- Supervise you while you are at TassieCare.
- Not be alone with you where we cannot be seen by other TassieCare staff.
- Ask your parents/guardian permission in writing before we:
 - Take you on an excursion.
 - Arrange overnight stays or camps; and/or
 - Provide transport to you.
- Ask you and your parents/guardians if its ok to take pictures of you.
- Not babysitting you, visit you at your home or give you gifts.
- Not call, text, or email you or make contact with you on social media.
- Give you guidance that is fair, respectful, and appropriate to your age and background; and
- Help you and other children if you feel unsafe, uncomfortable, or upset.

Responsibilities of Children and Young People at TassieCare

When you take part in an TassieCare activity, event, or program you also have to behave positively by:

- Telling a staff person or parent if you feel unsafe, upset, or uncomfortable.
- Treating other children and adults with respect.
- Following the rules of the activity, event, or program.
- Listening to others and being kind.
- Asking staff if you need to leave the activity.
- Having fun!
