The New Testament has much to say about what Jesus did for the repentant sinner. I have provided a beautiful summary of his great soteriological work. Please take a few minutes to reflect on the glory of Christ, and then I would like to point out what it does not say.

Jesus:

- 3) Cleanses the Heart by Faith (Act 15:9, Heb 9:14)

- 5) **Cleanses Us in Communion** (Matt 26:17-29, Matt 27:50-51, Mk 14:12-25, Lk 22:7-38, Heb 6:19-20, Heb 10:5-10, Heb 10:19-20, Eph 2:12-16, 1 Cor 1:28-33, 1 Cor 11:23- 25)
- 6) Circumcises the Heart from Sin (Rom 2:28-29)
- 7) **Died for Sins** (1Cor 15:3, 1 Cor 15:17)
- 8) **Died the Just for the Unjust** (1 Pet 3:18)
- 9) Forgave & Redeems Us form Our Sins (Eph 1:7, Col 1:13-14, Rom 3:21-31, Act 5:31, Acts 13:38-39)
- 10) Gave Himself for our Sins (Jn 10:15, Gal 1:4, Gal 2:20, Gal 3:13
- 11) Made Propitiation for Sins (Rom 3:25, Heb 2:17, 1 Jn 2:2, 1 Jn 4:10)
- 12) Made Purification for Sins (Heb 1:3, 1 Jn 7-9, Tit 2:11-14, Ps 51:1-2, Heb 9:22)
- 13) Makes Atonement as High Priest (Heb 2:14-18, Heb 10:19-22, Heb 9:23-28)
- 14) Nailed Past Sins to the Cross (Col 2:12-14, Act 3:19)
- 15) Offered Himself for Sin (Heb 7:27, Heb 10:5-10)
- 16) Put Away our Sins (Heb 9:14, Heb 9:26, Heb 10:12)
- 17) **Ransomed Us through the Life & Blood of Christ** (Matt 20:28, Mk 10:45, 1 Tim 2:6, 1Pet 1:18-19, Heb 9:22-24, Rev 5:9)
- 18) Reconciles Us by Christ's Death & Blood (Rom 5:10, Col 1:20-22)
- 19) Reconciles Jew and Gentile to God & All Things (Eph 2:16, Col 1:20)
- 20) **Redeemed Gentiles from the Curse**. The promise to Abraham (Gal 3:8, 13-14, Gen 12:1-3,7, 13:14-17, 15:1-7, 15;12, 15:18, 17:1-8, 22:15-18)
- 21) Redeemed Jews and Gentles from the Law of Moses (Gal 4:4-6)
- 22) Redeems First Covenant Transgressions (Heb 9:15)
- 23) Rescues Us from the Dominion of Darkness and Brings us into Christ's Kingdom (Col 1:13-14, Psa 2:6-7, Isa 9:6, Dan 7:14, Zech 9:9, Act 8:12, Act 28:31, 2 Pet 1:11)
- 24) Sacrificed for Sins (Heb 10:10-14, Heb 9:11-12, Tit 2:14)
- 25) Redeems & Saves his People (Matt 1:21, Lk 1:68, Ti 2:14)
- 26) Saves and Calls Sinners (1 Tim 1:15, Matt 9:13)
- 27) Set Us Free from Lawlessness & Sin (Titus 2:11-14, Rom 6:18)
- 28) Suffered for Sins (1 Pet 3:18. Rom 4:25, 1 Pet 4:1)
- 29) **Shed The Blood of the Covenant for Remission of Sins** (Matt 26.28, Rom 3:24-25, Rom 4:25, Eph 1:7, Rev 1:5)
- 30) Takes Away Our Sins (1Jn 3:5, Rom 11:27)
- 31) Washes Us From Our Sins in Christ's Blood (Rev 1:5, Rev 7:14, Zech 13:1)
- 32) Washes through Regeneration (Tit 3:4-7, Rom 8:9-14)

33) Washes/ Purified Us in the Rebirth (Tit 3:4-7, Jn 3:3-8, 1 Pet 1:23)

34) Washed Sanctified & Justified In Christ & the Spirit through Faith (1 Cor 6:11, 1 Cor 1:2, 1 Cor 1:30, Act 26:18, 2 The 2:13, Heb 2:11, 1 Pet 1:2, Rom 3:28-30, Rom 4:5)

35) Washing in Water, Saved & Sanctified in Baptism (Eph 5:26, 1 Pet 3:2, Matt 28:19, Mk 16:16, Acts 2:38, Acts 22:16, Rom 6:4-6, 1 Cor 12:13, Gal 3:27, Col 2:12)

Now that we have reflected on his glorious work let's discuss what the Bible never says. I provide an extreme warning: what I am about to say is so entrenched in evangelical thinking that your immediate response will be shock and disbelief. Are you ready?

Nowhere in the Bible does it ever say- "JESUS PAID THE PENALTY FOR OUR SIN", and I challenge anyone to provide such a verse in the Old or New Testament.

I hear this expression all the time. I hear it in the pulpits, and it is standard jargon in the evangelical church, yet this statement and supporting doctrine are very unbiblical.

This is another example of the church being infiltrated by heretical teachings.

If this doctrine is true, then every Christian can sin with impunity. Your past, present and future sins are automatically not held against you since the penalty for sin has already been paid.

This theology says that if you murder, the penalty is paid, and you are Scott-free. Is this rational, logical or biblical? It is not. How can God be just and fail to execute judgment when justice is demanded? Paul says in **Gal 6:6-7** *Do not be deceived: God is not mocked, for whatever one sows, that will he also reap. For the one who sows to his own flesh will from the flesh reap corruption, but the one who sows to the Spirit will from the Spirit reap eternal life.*

This penalty-paid heresy is widely accepted today in much of the Evangelical Church, as it was in Paul's day. He and others combated this lie with the following warnings.

Please review the following verses that refute the penalty paid heresy.

Warning Against Faithlessness (Not continuing to listen, believe and obey)

1) James 5:19-21 Turn brother from sin and save his soul 2) Gal 5:16-21 Walk in the flesh, and you will not inherit the kingdom Don't be deceived. You reap what you sow. The penalty-paid theology is a diabolical lie called the gospel of divine accomplishment. The true gospel is the gospel of divine transformation. (See Article 2 @ www.breakfreeapologetics.com/articles.

May I suggest you read the 39 references above in context? These and the testimony of the entire Bible do not support the <u>Penalty Paid Evangelical Doctrine</u>.

The devil has sowed seeds, and most of the church has planted and watered his doctrine.

The Bible reveals that the path to eternal life is entering and staying in a relationship/fellowship with the Father through Christ. We enter this relationship when we are baptized into Christ, dying to our old way of life (Acts 8:12, 36,38, 9:19, 10:44-48, 16:15,33, 18:8, 19:3-5, 22:16, Rom 6:1-14, 1 Cor 12:12-13, Gal 3:25-27, Col 2:12-15, Titus 3:5-6, 1 Pet 3:20). At baptism, we are forgiven and added to the church. (Acts 2:38) Our ongoing membership requires our faithfulness to Christ as our Lord, King and Priest. Christians are required to stay in a relationship with the Father through Christ, as all 39 scriptures above reveal. Atonement for sin is only available to those in relationship with Christ as revealed in **1 Jn 1:6-7** It says, *If we say*

we have <u>fellowship</u> with him while we <u>walk</u> in darkness, <u>we lie</u> and do not <u>practice</u> the <u>truth.</u> But if we walk in the light, as he is in the light, we have fellowship with one another, and the blood of Jesus his Son <u>cleanses</u> us from all sin.

Do not be deceived if you do not practice the truth. You are not in a relationship and, therefore, cannot receive cleansing from your sin. **1 Jn 1:9** says, "*If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness.*"

Why would you need ongoing forgiveness of sins if the penalty has already been paid? The answer is that you would not. Penalty-paid theology is transactional, not relational. Love and obedience are not transactional.

Do not be deceived. Christianity is about a relationship with the Father through his Son in the power of the Holy Spirit, evidenced below:

- 1) If you Love me, keep my Commands, then you can receive the Holy Spirit Jn 14:15-17
- 2) Love Preserves 1 Cor 13:1-7
- 3) Love Fulfills the Law of God Gal 5:13-14
- 4) Taught by God to Love 1 Thess 4:9
- 5) If Love you are in the Light 1 Jn 2:10-11
- 6) If you Love God, you must Love your Brother 1 Jn 4:21
- 7) God's children love God by carrying out his Commandments 1 Jn 5:2
- 8) What counts is Fatih expressing itself through Love Gal 5:6
- 9) Must practice the truth 1 Jn 1:6-7
- 10) If God is your Father, you will love Christ Jn 8:42, 14:2-24
- 11) My command is to Love One Another Jn 15:11-14
- 12) If you don't Love the Lord, be accursed 1 Cor 16:22

Stop perpetrating the lie. Jesus did not Pay the Penalty for Sin. If you keep saying this, you are helping Satan deceive the church. Jesus made it possible for us to be forgiven and be in a relationship with the Father through faith. This only happens if we listen to, believe in and obey Christ. The Apostle John put it this way in **John 3:36:** *Whoever believes in the Son has eternal life; whoever <u>does not obey the Son</u> shall not see life, but the wrath of God remains on him.*

Do not miss the connection between belief and obedience. Paul put it this way in **Rom 1:5**, *through whom we have received grace and apostleship to bring about the <u>obedience of faith</u> for <i>the sake of his name among the nations*.

We are saved by faith. Faith means that you listen, believe and obey God. Do not be deceived.

I close with Jesus' direct words in **Rev 3:3-6** *Remember* then what you received and heard. <u>Keep</u> <u>it, and repent</u>. If you <u>will not wake</u> up, I will come like a thief, and you will not know at what hour <u>I will come against you.</u> 4 Yet you have still a few names in Sardis, people who have not soiled their garments, and they will walk with me in white, for they <u>are worthy</u>. 5 The one <u>who</u> <u>conquers</u> will be clothed thus in white garments, and <u>I will never blot his name out of the book</u> <u>of life.</u> I will confess his name before my Father and before his angels. 6He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.

A Few Questions:

- 1) Why would a believer need to be worthy if their penalty was paid?
- 2) Why is Jesus calling his Church to repentance with a promise not to blot their name from the Book of Life?
- 3) Under penalty-paid theology, your name cannot be removed from the Book of Life, so why is Jesus saying your name could be removed?
- 4) Why is Jesus saying he will only confess the names of the worthy before his Father?
- 5) Jesus says that only those who conquer will be clothed in white.
- 6) Why will Jesus fight against those who do not wake up?
- 7) Do you have ears to hear? Will you believe Jesus, or will you continue to believe the lie of penalty-paid theology?
