- Include an essay no less than 150 words and no more than 500 words on what "Service Above Self" means to you
- Additional consideration will be given to students who qualify for free and reduced-price food programs (guidance counselor to verify eligibility).
- Application must be filled out in its entirety, including your essay (you may indicate if something is not applicable to you)

- Class Rank (from your transcript summary or your college & career counselor may assist)
- Un-weighted & weighted GPA (Can also be found on your transcript summary)

#### 6.) Non-School Related Civic Activities

• Items 4-6 only fill out those blanks, where applicable to you. If you need additional space, attach a separate sheet of paper.

## 7.) State your plans for enrollment in an accredited College, University or Trade School

• Everyone must fill this out. Example: I plan to enroll at USF for the fall semester and study business administration and graduate with my bachelor's degree before continuing to graduate school.

#### 8.) Applicant Essay (Statement)

• Everyone must submit an essay. Essay must be no fewer than 150 and no more than 500 words.

#### 9.) Permanent Transcript Summary

Everyone must submit a permanent transcript summary.

#### 10.) Consideration for financial need

• Students seeking additional consideration for financial need must have school counselor provide verification of eligibility for free and reduced-price food programs. This is the ONLY criteria that will be accepted for financial need consideration.
