
Organic fluid forms are the key elements of the collection. Hence, to retain the same sculpted form in metal the piece was made using sand casting technique.



Suvarnam is an occasional wear jewellery collection, designed especially for the occasion of Diwali. The designs of this collection are inspired from hampi architecture.






A bowl is made inspired from the geometric form of swan using slab technique.
