**TREASURER REPORT**: Treasurer Leila Rish reported that \$1,861.50 was received by the water vendor in July 2020 and reported on the Village's account balances. CD rates remain very low and she will roll those CD's over for another 90 days. As of July 20, \$14,757.31 has been received from the Village summer taxes with \$107,684.59 remaining. Village summer taxes are due September 30, 2020.

**<u>FIRE DEPARTMENT</u>**: The ACW-Unionville Fire Department financial report was presented. The Fire Department purchased a drone and a thermal imaging camera. The old SBA system and other equipment was sold. The mid-year payroll is currently being processed. The next Fire Board Meeting will be held on August 5, 2020.

**POLICE:** Bill Owens, Police Chief, gave the June Police Activity report to the Council. He also reported on the grants that he is applying for. He is continuing to work with the blighted properties within the Village.

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**<u>STREETS & SIDEWALKS</u>**: Sidewalk work will begin at the end of August. We are still waiting to hear if our application was accepted by Community Service Infrastructure Fund – TEDF Category B grant.
