

Questionnaire for Prospective Puppy Buyers

Thank you for inquiring about Elvbend Elkhounds. We are dedicated breed fanciers who participate in various arenas of competition. We breed occasionally to produce what we believe to be quality Norwegian Elkhounds that conform to the breed standard, are intelligent, and able to do what the Elkhound was originally bred to do. We also strive to produce physically and temperamentally sound dogs.

Through competition and membership in both local and national clubs, we are exposed to other points of view, educational programs, and updated rules and regulations. More importantly, we have an opportunity to share concerns, information, and ideas with other concerned and knowledgeable dog people.

Elvbend makes sure our puppies, or any that we refer, are going to loving, committed homes. We do our best to screen new owners to ensure a good match between puppy and buyer. All litters are temperament tested using a Puppy Aptitude Test. As much as possible, we attempt to evaluate the personality of puppies by observing them during their development. We then attempt to match the puppy to the new owner to produce the best fit of puppy and family. For this reason, you may not be allowed to pick your puppy from an entire litter. After an extensive inquiry into your lifestyle and home arrangements, you may be given two or three puppies to choose from. We do this to insure the likelihood of a fulfilling and rewarding relationship with your new puppy. We do reserve the right to refuse purchase if we feel that you and an Elkhound are not an appropriate match.

Before any puppy leaves our home, it has been well cared for and socialized. However, a puppy does not go to its new owner as a trained, well-mannered, finished product. It is up to the puppy buyer to complete the job we have started. The new owner is responsible for the further development of the puppy's personality, through structured discipline, training, guidance, and love. In an effort to ensure that our puppies develop into the treasured adult dogs they are capable of becoming, we ask new owners to commit to taking their new puppy to at least one full session of puppy socialization classes offered locally.

All of our pet/companion puppies are sold on a Limited Registration, which means that your pet may not be bred. We request that these puppies are spayed or neutered. Show/Showable puppies will be placed with Full Registration, whether purchased on a co-ownership or a full ownership contract.

Do you understand that if Elvbend places an Elkhound with you, the puppy/dog will be solely your responsibility for the remainder of its life?
Do you understand that NO dog placed or referred by Elvbend can be placed in a pet shelter? In order to obtain a puppy through Elvbend, you must agree to that you will never place the dog/puppy in a shelter; that if you are unable or unwilling to keep the puppy, you will immediately notify Elvbend?
Are you willing to maintain a current address/phone with Elvbend (notify us if you move)?
Please list two references (name, address, phone). One may be your veterinarian.
Any dog placed by Elvbend shall be maintained in a home atmosphere. Adequate food, water, shelter, training, affection, and medical care will be provided by the new owner. It is the prospective owner's responsibility to see and evaluate the dog before adopting it. Elvbend Elkhounds is in no way liable or responsible for any damages, accident, or injury resulting from placing a dog in the prospective buyer's household.
Completion of this application does not guarantee placement of an Elkhound. This application is designed to determine the proper fit of an Elkhound in the home. Elvbend reserves the right to refuse placement if such placement is deemed inappropriate. Contract of sale will be issued in the event of an approved puppy purchase. Failure to comply with terms of adoption information and contract will result in the return of the dog to Elvbend without refund to the purchaser.
