



LeadLine Walk Trot Test A 2023

TEST INFORMATION

- LeadLine walk/trot Ages: Up to 12 years.
- The horse must be lead at the shoulder, on the left side.
- Leader must hold the lead at least one foot from the clip in the right hand.
- Rider must be seen to be directing the horse.
- The horse on the LeadLine at all times.
- A caller is permitted.
- The test can be ridden in English or Western Tack.
- ARENA SIZE: Standard AVERAGE RIDETIME: 3:30

Medium Walk:

Regular and unconstrained with the handler taking care to keep the rider safely balanced in the saddle during movements.

Trot:

Regular and unconstrained with the handler taking care to keep the rider safely balanced in the saddle during movements. May be rising or sitting.
