Entries open April 21st, 2025 at 12:01 AM. PRE-ENTRIES CLOSE 12 PM June 18, 2025 at the Trial Secretary's address or when numerical limits are reached if before June 18, 2025. Late entries will be accepted with a late entry fee of \$5.00 per entry if numerical limits have not been reached by Pre-Entry closing date. Please include a note with your entry if you need a morning or afternoon run time and we will do our best to accommodate. But if you are scheduled for the afternoon, please do not come in the morning.

ENTRY FEE \$25.00 pre-entry per dog per test (Includes \$3.50 AKC recording fee) There will be a \$15.00 service charge for any returned check Entries received post close after June 18, 2025 are \$30.00 for each entry. Day of show entries accepted as space allows. A stand-by list will be created and these dogs will be allowed to run if time permits. If the trial has not filled, day of show entries will be accepted for each day's respective trial and dogs not registered by that time will be considered absent. Incomplete, unsigned, or conditional entries will not be accepted. Entries will be acknowledged by email if legible email address is provided in the entry form. Please fill out entire entry form and include your dog's Fast CAT Handicap.

PLEASE NOTE: If entry is sent via next day air service (UPS), Airborne Express, Federal Express, Express Mail, etc., please indicate that no signature is necessary upon arrival or entry may not be accepted.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

All dogs must have an AKC registration number and be at least one year of age on the day of the trial. Dogs may only run once per test. All entries must be accompanied with a Check payable to Lake Shore Great Dane Club to be valid. Incomplete entries or forms without a signature will not be accepted. Fast CAT events are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with the foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative

Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners Program. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid Dogs are eligible to participate.

MIXED BREED DOGS that have been listed with AKC Canine Partners may participate provided their listing number has been recorded on the entry form. Breed should be marked as "All American Dog".

NOT REGISTERED WITH AKC: You can register your dog through the AKC Canine Partners program the day of event. Breed will be marked as "All American Dog." Please contact the Event Secretary for more details. Qualified runs during the weekend will be counted toward your title.

ONLINE ENTRY: Entries may also be accepted by filling out the Online Entry Form. Payment can be made directly through the entry form through PayPal or a check can be mailed after completing the form. A \$1 per entry convenience fee will be added to all entries PAID ONLINE.

ENTRY FEES SHALL NOT BE REFUNDED if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by veterinarian or judge, or barred from competition by action of the Event Committee. If, because of riots, civil disturbance, or other acts beyond the control of the test-giving Club, it is impossible to open or complete the Test, no refund of entry fees will be made.

REFUNDS WILL BE MADE if, in the opinion of the Inspection Committee, for any entry found to be lame, unfit to compete, a female in season or for any other reason found to be barred from competition according to regulations governing this event. Refunds for bitches in season will be refunded less \$3.50 per run if requests are submitted to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of judging for the day.

RUN ORDER: Upon processing of signed entries and entry fees, a confirmation will be emailed to exhibitors. Run order will be assigned before the event, the trial secretary will send a run order out to all exhibitors via the email to which entry confirmation has been sent.

RIBBON PRIZES: A Light Blue Ribbon will be awarded to each dog receiving a qualifying score. Special larger ribbons/rosettes will be awarded for dogs completing advanced titles.

Please advise the Trial Secretary before the closing date if you expect to earn a title so that an award is ready if you are successful. Rosettes are only guaranteed to those who inform the Trial Secretary before June 15, 2025. All other awards received will be mailed.

WHAT IS FAST CAT?

Fast CAT (Fast Coursing Ability Test) is a timed straight 100 yard dash for dogs. Dogs are held at the start line and the coursing lure is activated prompting the dog to follow chasing it to the finish line and into a catch pen. The course is completely fenced and dogs are run individually. Dogs are timed when they complete the 100 yard dash. The time is converted to miles per hour (MPH).

FORMULA: 204.545 / RUN TIME = MPH

MPH X HANDICAP = POINTS (Rounded to the nearest 0.01 MPH)

A dog's handicap is determined by the height of the dog at the withers, a handicap is applied and points are earned.

18" or greater = Handicap multiplier - 1.0

12" to 18" = Handicap multiplier - 1.5

12"and below= Handicap multiplier - 2.0

Titles are earned at specific point levels and the highest suffix may appear after the dog's name:

BCAT = 150 points

DCAT = 500 points

FCAT = 1000 points

FCAT2 = 1500 points

FCAT#... For each additional 500 points

Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The Inspection committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into a test. At roll call, all dogs will be measured by a wicket to verify handicaps.

Please do not bring bitches in season to the test!

TOP 20 BY BREED BY YEAR The AKC fast cat website will feature the top 20 fastest dogs by breed by year national standings. The standings will be updated as event results are processed at https://www.apps.akc.org/apps/fastcat ranking

HOURS Roll Call and visual inspection begin no later than 7:45 AM. It is the responsibility of each entrant to make an effort to be ready when their dog is called to the line. The runs begin at 8 AM and 1:00PM until all runs are completed. For the safety of our volunteers and participants, lightning is the only reason to cause the postponement and or cancellation of an event.

Lake Shore Great Dane Club Rules

- ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNER'S SOLE RISK
- All dogs must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the test.
- All dogs must be leashed on trial property. No electronic or prong collars permitted on trial grounds.
- All AKC rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply.
- This is it rain or shine outdoor event. Please plan accordingly. Please bring your own shade, chairs and water.
- Run times will be scheduled as entries are received and an email will be sent to entrants with this information. If you need to have an earlier or later run time please contact the Test Secretary for an adjustment in your run time.
- The grounds are not completely fenced.
- The Fast CAT course is completely fenced.
- Bathrooms will be available.
- All dogs must be on a lead or crated unless running.
- Owners are expected to clean up after their dogs.
- Each dog requires an individual entry form.
- You're responsible for controlling your dog or dogs and children.
- Bitches in season and lame dogs will be excused.
- The field committee is responsible for field safety and therefore in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, they have the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve the dog on the course.
- Dogs and or persons exhibiting conduct detrimental to Lake Shore Great Dane Club/AKC will be asked to leave the trial site by the field committee and may be disciplined by the AKC. Entry fees will not be refunded.
- Fees shall not be refunded in the event a dog is absent. No entry fees will be
 refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil
 disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, acts of God,
 public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other causes beyond the
 control of Lake Shore Great Dane Club.
- The event hosting club, Lake Shore Great Dane Club, its agents, members, representatives, volunteers, etc., assume no liability or responsibility for any loss, damages or injuries sustained by exhibitors, handler's, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators before, during, or after this event.
- These tests will run concurrently.
- For dogs running in both events on the same day, they must be inspected prior to each run.
