





## **ENTRY FEES**

- \$27 per run for all entries received prior to April 19, 2026 at 6:00pm CT. Price includes \$4.50 AKC recording fee.
- \$32 per run for all entries received after the April 19, 2026 at 6:00pm CT.

Entries Open on Wednesday February 25, 2026, 6:00pm CT and close on Sunday, April 19, 2026 at 6:00pm CT or when limits are reached. In the event limits are not reached, entries will be accepted on the day of the event.

Day of show entries will only be accepted first come first serve as space permits until the cap of 160 entries is reached. **Entries only accepted online at [www.secreterrier.com](http://www.secreterrier.com) and no other methods of pre-entry will be permitted. Online entries have a credit card processing fee added per entry. Mailed paper entries with checks will be rejected and destroyed.**

## **ENTRY INSTRUCTIONS**

*Please note, this form/link will not be active until the opening date.*

Please complete the online entry form for each dog you wish to enter. Enter your dog's AKC Number (Purebred, PAL/ILP, or Canine Partners Number) when you register.

In the event that entries do not meet the 160 dogs cap, at the time of entry closing, we will accept day-of entries on a first come basis, through the same link. No cash/checks will be accepted at the FastCAT site.

## **FUN RUNS**

Fun runs will be available as space allows. Sign ups will be available through Secreterrier, accessible online or by scanning the QR code at the FastCAT grounds.

---

## **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

Entries will be limited to 160 dogs per event, two events daily running concurrently beginning at 8:00AM. Run your dog with a small break between runs if entered twice, and you are free to leave after both runs.

All refunds are subject to a \$3.00 administrative fee per entry.  
No refunds after the closing date.

Participants may select a time block when entering the event through Secreterrier. Volunteer dogs will run in the first hour.

Dogs must have an AKC registration number and be at least one year of age on the day of the event. Dogs may only run once per event. Entries received by phone, text, postal mail, or email will not be accepted. Incomplete entries will not be accepted.

Fast CAT events are open to all dogs at least 12 months of age that are individually registered with the AKC, recorded in the Foundation Stock Service (FSS) program, individually registered with a foreign or domestic registry organization whose pedigrees are acceptable for AKC registration, dogs granted a Purebred Alternative Listing (PAL) number, dogs with AKC Limited or Conditional Registration, or dogs enrolled in the AKC Canine Partners program. Dogs with breed disqualifications and monorchid/cryptorchid dogs are eligible to participate.

---

## **COURSE INFORMATION**

The entire 100-yard course will be run outdoors on a grass surface. Length of runout area past the finish line will be at least 50 yards long. Fencing will be portable sheep fencing.

This event will use a drag lure system with electronic timers. The lure will be a white plastic bag.

---

## **WHAT IS FASTCAT?**

Fast CAT is a timed straight 100-yard dash for dogs. Dogs are held at the start line and the coursing lure is activated prompting the dog to follow chasing it to the finish line and into a catch pen. The course is completely fenced, and dogs are run individually. Dogs are timed when they complete the 100-yard dash. The time is converted to Miles Per Hour (MPH).

FORMULA:  $204.545 / \text{RUN TIME} = \text{MPH}$

$\text{MPH} \times \text{HANDICAP} = \text{POINTS (ROUNDED TO NEAREST 0.01)}$

Based on the dog's size at the withers, a handicap is applied, and points are earned:

- 18" or greater = Handicap is 1.0
- 12" up to less than 18" = Handicap is 1.5.
- Below 12" = Handicap is 2.0.

$\text{MPH} \times \text{HANDICAP} = \text{POINTS}$

Titles are earned at specific point levels and the highest suffix may appear after the dog's name:

BCAT = 150 points

DCAT = 500 points

FCAT = 1,000 points

FCAT# = Each additional 500 points

Coursing is an athletic activity that can tax a dog's physical strength. Dogs that are overweight and/or out of condition may be at greater risk for injury and exhaustion. The Inspection Committee has the authority to disallow a dog's entry into an event and, in such instances, applicable entry fees will be refunded. Dogs will be examined for lameness before running. Bitches in season, lame and unfit dogs will be excused with entry refunded. **Please do not bring bitches in season to the event that are not competing.**

---

## **EVENT HOURS**

Visual inspection begins no later than 7:45 AM. Club volunteers will be in the first time block at 8:00 and we will run dogs until all runs are completed. We recommend you arrive at least 15 minutes prior to your run block so that you may check in, exercise your dog, and get in line to run. If you have entered both events for the same day, you will check in a second time at the inspection table, and get in line again after your first run, taking into account any cool-down time your dog requires.

---

## **PRIZES AND ROSETTES**

The club will offer a light blue flat ribbon for a passing qualifying run. The Club will have a limited number of title rosettes available. Please notify the event chair via email if you will be earning a new title to ensure that the club will have rosettes available.

The club will offer a rosette to each of the Top 5 fastest clumber spaniels based on each dog's fastest run of the day, and a special rosette to the slowest clumber spaniel with a qualifying run each day.

## **EVENT SITE DIRECTIONS**

From Highway 10 – Take US-10 to Exit 230 for County Rd J. Turn right onto County Rd J. Turn right onto Burr Oak Road. Country Paws Canine Athletic Center will be on the right and the Fast CAT track on the left.

---

### **EVENT INFORMATION**

- Dogs should be warmed up before and cooled down after running.
- ALL DOGS RUN AT OWNER'S SOLE RISK

- All dogs must be 12 months of age or older on the day of the event.
- All dogs must be leashed on event property. No electronic or prong collars permitted on event grounds. No retractable leads are permitted on event grounds.
- All AKC rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply.
- This is a rain-or-shine outdoor event. Please plan accordingly.
- Please bring your own shade, chairs and water.
- An electronic timing system will be used. A **drag lure** will be used.
- The show grounds are not completely fenced. The FAST CAT course will be fenced.
- Dogs must be on lead or crated unless running.
- A \$5 fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field not competing, or an exhibitor caught not picking up after their dog.
- You are responsible for controlling your dog(s) and children.
- There is livestock on the event grounds. Any dog found harassing the livestock will be excused from the trial with no refund. There will be no exceptions.
- Bitches in season and lame dogs will be excused.
- The Huntmaster is responsible for field safety and therefore he/she is in complete charge of all dogs and handlers on the field. In service to this responsibility, he/she has the authority to stop the lure in any potentially dangerous situation and signal the handler to retrieve the dog on the course.
- Dog(s) and/or person(s) exhibiting conduct detrimental to the AKC will be asked to leave the event site by the Event Committee and may be disciplined by the AKC. Entry fees will not be refunded.
- No entry fees will be refunded if the event cannot be started or completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the club.
- The event-hosting club, its agents, members, representatives, volunteers, etc., assume no liability or responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children or spectators before, during, or after this event.
