

Shoreline Building Permit Documentation Requirements

The Hanover Planning Board requires the any building permit application for shoreline property must include the following:

1. A written description of the alteration to be made.
2. A scaled and dimensions plan view drawing to the present and planned site including setbacks from the shoreline and property boundaries. Photos of the existing property including all buildings.
3. A scaled and dimensioned plan view drawing of the present and proposed building.
4. Scaled and dimensioned elevation drawings of all four sides of the present and proposed building
5. Calculation of the present and planned footprint square footage.
6. Calculation of the present and planned building cube.
7. Photos of the completed construction property including all buildings.
