

RNBA Umpire Assistance Program

To assist in the development of Umpires in the Province of New Brunswick, Rowing New Brunswick Aviron is introducing the Umpire Assistance Program. The program goal is to assist in the support existing umpires to travel to sanctioned competitions outside their own club. This will also help Umpires in training to get their required experience.

The assistance breaks down as follows:

- \$40 towards travel to a sanctioned regatta within the Province and outside of their Club.
- \$80 towards travel and accommodations to a sanctioned regatta outside the Province, excluding any National appointed Jury, as these expenses are covered.
- An individual cannot exceed \$120 per calendar year.

To ensure that as many umpires benefit from this program, An individual cannot receive more than \$120 in a calendar year

To be eligible a candidate must be at least an RCA Level 1 umpire or Umpire in Training and a member of an organization that is a member of RNBA. (Kennebecasis Rowing Club or Fredericton Rowing Club)

To apply for this subsidy, the candidate must have this form signed by the Chairman of the Regatta attended. The form is then submitted to the Treasurer of RNBA, and copied to the Chief Umpire for New Brunswick, for reimbursement
