Fundraising Update

In total, with the support of so many generous people, we have raised \$3,735 in the past two months. Currently your funds have helped support financial needs such as tax filing, business supplies, opening a bank account, and opening a PO box.

Our third quarter fundraising goal is \$15,000. The funds from the third quarter will go towards purchasing a phone, service fees, and other costs associated with running our Family Resource Phone Line.



In other news, Ramsey Crisis Nursery has located a home in Saint Paul, MN to be used for our overnight care services. This particular home meets many of the licensing requirements needed to run Ramsey Crisis Nursery and already provides the comforts of a cozy home. This home is still on the market and we are hoping to raise funds and receive grants in order to purchase this home. Please note that any extra funds received while fundraising for our Family Resource Phone Line will go towards purchasing this home.
