Golden canna	Canna flaccida	Wetland plant, Larval host for Brazilian skipper
Goldenrod – Pinebarren	Solidago fistulosa	
Hammock twinflower	Dyschoriste humistrata	Larval host for Common Buckeye butterfly
Lakeside sunflower	Helianthus carnosus	
Lanceleaf coreopsis	Coreopsis lanceolata	
Lizard's tail	Saururus cernuus	Wetland plant
Meadowbeauty	Rhexia sp.	Wetland plant
Pickereelweed	Pontederia cordata	Wetland/aquatic plant
Rayless sunflower	Helianthus radula	
Scarlet hibiscus	Hibiscus coccineus	Wetland plant
Spider lily	Hymenocallis latifolia	
Spiderwort	Tradescantia ohiensis

Twinflower	Dyschoriste oblongifolia	Larval host for Common Buckeye butterfly
White violet	Viola primulifolia	Good for shade
Wild petunia	Ruellia caroliniensis	Larval host for Common Buckeye & White Peacock butterflies

Shrubs

Beautyberry	Callicarpa americana	Birds eat the berries
Coontie	Zamia integrifolia	Evergreen
Firebush 1 & 3-gal (\$10)	Hamelia patens	Attracts hummingbirds
Oakleaf hydrangea 3-gal (\$10)	Hydrangea quercifolia	Full or part shade
Privet cassia	Senna ligustrina	Larval host for Cloudless Sulphur, Sleepy Orange and the introduced Orange-Barred Sulphur butterflies
Simpson's stopper	Myrcianthes fragrans	Plants less than 1 year old
Sleepy hibiscus	Hibiscus furcellatus	Shrubby wildflower
Sweet acacia	Vachellia farnesiana	Shrub or very small tree
Wild coffee	Psychotria nervosa	Prefers part to full shade
Wild coffee (Dull-leaf)	Psychotria tenuifolia	Prefers part to full shade
Yellow Star anise	Illicium parviflorum	Prefers part to full shade

Vines

Coral honeysuckle	Lonicera sempervirens	Attracts hummingbirds
Climbing aster	Symphotrichum caroliniensis	
Wild plumbago	Plumbago zeylanica	Vine or groundcover. Larval host for Cassius blue butterfly. Does well in shade

Grass

Muhly grass	Muhlenbergia capillaris	Perennial clumping grass
Elliott's love grass	Eragrostis elliotii	
Purple love grass	Eragrostis spectabilis	

Groundcover

Browne's savory	Clinopodium brownei	Fragrant leaves
Creeping sage	Salvia misella	
Frogfruit	Phyla nodiflora	Flowering groundcover. Larval host for Phaon Crescent, White Peacock and Common Buckeye butterflies
Sunshine mimosa	Mimosa strigillosa	Flowering groundcover
