

Joseph F. Healey Memorial Scholarship

The Board of Directors of the Joseph F. Healey Memorial Golf Tournament is pleased to announce the Joseph F. Healey Memorial Scholarship to those students enrolled full-time in any educational program above the high school-level at the time of the announcement of the award. The scholarship is open to all students who either work in the golf industry or are members of golf clubs in either Massachusetts or New Hampshire. Additionally, all applicants must reside in either Massachusetts or New Hampshire. The Joseph F. Healey organization has helped students to meet the rising costs of a college education by awarding over \$93, 500 in scholarships to date.

The Joseph F. Healey Memorial Scholarship Fund Committee will be responsible for awarding the scholarships to deserving students. The award will be based on an applicant's knowledge of the life and contributions of Joseph F. Healey, academic performance, character, involvement in extra-curricular and community activities and a personal essay. The semi-finalists will be invited to attend an interview.

The Board of Directors takes great pleasure in inviting our youth to actively pursue this scholarship in memory of "Joe" Healey. Joe was a graduate of Methuen High School who turned his passion for golf, which was instilled in him by his father, into a career as a golf professional. From his beginnings at George Gelt's Crystal Springs Golf Club to his tutelage by Ted Murphy at Garrison Golf Center, Joe went on to a successful career as the Director of Golf and Head Professional at a number of area golf clubs.

As a successful junior golfer, Joe won many titles including, The Boston Globe Junior Golf Championship, two Junior Rogers Championships and a New England Junior Title. Later in life, Joe acquired a new passion and secondary career as a basketball official, where he again excelled. He worked countless high school and NCAA games throughout all of the divisions. Joe truly enjoyed organizing officials for the Greater Lawrence Christmas Basketball Tournament, but what Joe found most rewarding was the camaraderie of the industry and the mentoring of aspiring, young golfers. He was a long-standing member of the PGA of America, The NEPGA, The National Association of Sports Officials, the CBOA and the IAABO.

The Joseph F. Healey Memorial Scholarship Eligibility Requirements and Program Description

Scholarship awards will be based on the following criteria:

- Academic performance
- Character
- Involvement in extra-curricular and community activities
- Personal essay
- Interview, as semi-finalists will be invited to attend
- Knowledge of the life and contributions of Joseph F. Healey

Please note that no awards will be withheld or denied to any person on the basis of race, religion, sex or national origin.

Terms of Scholarship Benefits

Awards will be made on a competitive basis to students pursuing a college, university or higher-level degree. Students must be enrolled full-time during the semester of the announcement of the award and must either work in the golf industry or be a member of a golf club in either Massachusetts or New Hampshire. Students must also reside in either Massachusetts or New Hampshire. The Joseph F. Healey Memorial Scholarship Fund Committee will be responsible for determining award amounts.

Payment of Scholarship Award

A check from the Joseph F. Healey Memorial Scholarship fund will be awarded directly to the recipient (or the guardians of the recipient) of the scholarship upon verification of enrollment in an appropriate academic program, residency and employment or membership. The scholarship award can be applied towards the expense of tuition, fees, books and other service charges regularly collected by the business office of the learning institution. At the end of one year, verification of the appropriate use of the scholarship funds will be required. If the scholarship was not used appropriately or not used completely, the award must be returned to the Joseph F. Healey Memorial Scholarship fund.

All forms are maintained in the strictest confidence and will be destroyed after completion of the scholarship award deliberations. The scholarship award will be distributed by the Committee upon receipt of acceptable documents confirming acceptance and registration.
