Study, Prayer, and Community, all build up, lead to, and strengthen our preaching.

#### A book club

- 1. We do not see the need to get together and be formed by each other.
- We come and go to our meetings as our schedule allows.
- 3. We give our opinions about the book we are reading, but we do not know one another deeply nor share our faith.
- 4. I like coming to the group. I like the people there.
- 5. We are comforted by the books we read and the opinions of the other members.

#### **Dominican Community**

- 1. We value regular consistent time together.
- 2. We are committed to each other. The good and the not so good.
- 3. We share our lives and our mission in a real and authentic way.
- We see each other (and all Dominicans) as brother and sister.
- We are challenged and supported by our brothers and sisters in our community.
   Communal life is sometimes a place of challenge, and sometimes a place of unity.

#### A Book Club

- We do not see the need nor the value in praying together.
- We do not deliberately pray for each other.My prayers are "Me and Jesus."
- 3. We do not have a calendar for praying for the dead.
- 4. We go to this event so that I can grow. My actions largely affect me (only).
- 5. Our intellectual development is at the center of our meetings

#### Dominican Prayer

- "When two or more are gathered together in my name..."
- As the Body of Christ, we are connected to one another through prayer. We rely on one another for prayerful support.
- We value our obligations to pray for our deceased family throughout the Liturgical year.
- We understand and value that our penances can make a difference for others, now and forever.
- The Mass and liturgy are at the center of our lives.

### What is Dominican Study?



- -Focuses on the Word of God
- -Is Ongoing and Lifelong
- -Nourishes Contemplation
- -Is an Observance (ascetic)
- -Is not optional
- -Truth brings us closer to God
- -Truth becomes a person
- -is a devotion (way of prayer without ceasing)
- -for the whole person and community
- -is a responsibility (to have answers)
- -combines knowledge with charity
- -is not an end, but for the Salvation of Souls
- -Is for the Preaching to be useful to others.

#### **Dominican Study**

- Study is always for the preaching (never exclusively for our own benefit). Therefore, it is selfless, always for the other.
- 2. Engages the entire person.
- 3. Material is interiorized / "devoured."
- Uses the head and the heart.
- 5. Is a sacred activity.
- 6. Listen to and understand "all" views.
- 7. Takes great effort.
- 8. Is supernaturally motivated.
- 9. Connects us to the poor and suffering.
- 10. Responds to what is most urgently needed for the Preaching.
- 11. Is interested in "all" things. (Eternal)
- 12. Integrates science and devotion.
- 13. Motivated to know and love God.

#### a Book Club

- 1. We join and choose our books on what gives us individually the most benefit.
- 2. Engages our mind.
- 3. Material is learned / understood.
- 4. Uses the head.
- 5. Is a secular activity.
- 6. Proposes one view.
- 7. Is a leisure activity.
- 8. Is practically motivated.
- 9. Is more for our own enjoyment.
- 10. Involves what I am interested in.
- 11. Presents one thing. (Here and now).
- 12. Separates faith and reason.
- 13. Motivated to know and love things.

#### All leads us to our mission as preachers

- Is God's Words.
- 2. Is teaching (for the good of the soul).
- 3. We trust in God.
- 4. Speaks the Truth.
- 5. Leads to salvation.
- 6. God chooses the topic.
- 7. We are sent by God.
- 8. Is a moment of humility. We are not worthy.
- 9. Is backed with / by Scripture.
- 10. Is always communal.
- 11. Is done with/for/in/on behalf of the Church.
- 12. Continues the act of God's creation.
- 13. Always, anytime, anywhere, with anybody.
- 14. Takes risk for the sake of the Gospel.

#### Public Speaking

- 1. Is our words.
- 2. Is proposing a worldy objective.
- We trust in self.
- 4. Speaks the opinion of the presenter.
- 5. Leads to understanding or motivation.
- 6. We choose the topic.
- 7. We are asked by others.
- 8. Is a moment of confidence.
- 9. Is backed by / with evidence.
- 10. Is done by an individual.
- 11. Is done by an individual.
- 12. Proposes an agenda.
- 13. Time, place, and audience are often set.
- 14. Seeks consensus.
