- [+] In the name of the Father, and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.
- V. Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee.
- R. Blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus.
- V. O Lord, open my lips. (trace sign of cross on lips)
- R. And my mouth will announce your praise.
- V. [+] Incline unto my aid, O God.
- R. O Lord, make haste to help me.
- V. Glory to the Father and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit;
- R. As it was in the beginning is now and will be forever. Amen. Alleluia.

Each mystery of the Rosary is announced, followed by:

- The Lord's Prayer:
 - V. Our Father, who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name: Thy kingdom come: Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven.
 - R. Give us this day our daily bread: and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us. And lead us not into temptation: but deliver us from evil. Amen.
- 10 Hail Mary's:
 - V. Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee: blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus.
 - R. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen
- Glory Be to the Father:
 - V. Glory be to the Father, and to the Son and to the Holy Spirit.
 - o R. As it was in the beginning, is now and ever shall be, world without end. Amen.
- The Fatima Prayer:
 - o V. O my Jesus,
 - R. forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell. Lead all souls to Heaven, especially those in most need of Your Mercy

After the final mystery:

- V. Hail, Holy Queen,
- R. Mother of Mercy! Our Life, our Sweetness and our Hope! To thee do we cry, poor banished children of Eve; to thee do we send up our sighs, mourning and weeping in this valley of tears. Turn, then, most gracious advocate, thine eyes of mercy towards us, and after this, our exile, show unto us the blessed fruit of thy womb, Jesus. O clement, O loving, O sweet Virgin Mary!

- R. That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.
- V. May the Divine Assistance remain always with us;
