Spring and summer are on the horizon. Our next several months will be characterized by sun on our faces, star-filled skies sitting around the campfire as well as incredible leisure-time opportunities and adventures that we embark on together. As we head down that road of togetherness, I'll take a few minutes to update you on many parks and recreation happenings slated for Victor this season.

In accordance with our goal of continued safety improvements for pedestrians and bicyclists throughout the Town and Village, we will be installing a series of rapid flashing warning beacons at some of the crosswalks in the Auburn Trail corridor which traverses our community. While we all understand that Victor is a vibrant and growing community, the Department of Parks and Recreation wants to ensure that the needs of pedestrians and bicyclists are taken into account when traveling our often-busy roads. The rapid flashing beacons are another way of communicating to drivers that there is someone else out there with them.

In June, the Village of Victor Department of Public Works, in collaboration with our department, will embark on Phase Two of capital improvements to Harlan Fisher Park. These enhancements include a "new" parking area, drainage work, sidewalk connections, landscaping and more! We are looking forward to providing better access to the park and creating more neighborhood connections. Thanks also go out to resident pet lovers and BIG dog park fans Gerry Varone and Lynn and Richard Crowley for their kind donations to the park including the recently added "Dog Treat Library" and "Dog Leash Holders." These community-based projects are truly what personify Victor as a special place to live and recreate.

Arbor Day will be celebrated by our Tree Board on Saturday, April 26th at Victor Municipal Park with a ceremony involving the planting of over twenty "new" London Plane trees to welcome you into this feature park. This annual event would not be possible without the generous donation from our partners at Van Bortel Subaru and the numerous community groups and volunteers who come to support this cherished activity. Please consider coming out to the park on this day (or every day!)

Our summer event line-ups are all set and will feature numerous chances to catch live, local music at the Sid Partington Memorial Summer Concerts, Taco Tuesdays at Dryer Road Park and the Victor Food and Music Festival! KIDS (AND FAMILY) FRIENDLY BIKE FEST

The Victor Parks and Recreation, Citizens' Advisory Committee with the support of the Victor PTSA, is pleased to present a fun cycling activity for Victor kids, ages 5-18 years old and their families. Experienced volunteer cyclists will do a quick safety check on your bikes and make needed adjustments. Younger, less experienced cyclists are invited to participate in a Bike Rodeo to learn about Bike Safety and work on Basic Bike Handling Skills. A ride to Mendon, (approx. 3 miles, round trip) will take place after the Rodeo on the Lehigh Trail where we'll stop for a snack at the Mendon Ice S'coops! Older, more experienced riders are invited to participate in a longer ride on the Lehigh, which will also include a stop at the Mendon Ice S'coops. All rides will be led (and swept) by experienced adult cyclists. There will be Swag for your bikes. Helmets are required. AQUATICS PROGRAMS

NEW AND IMPROVED LEARN TO SWIM INFORMATION!

Private Lessons (AGES 2-12):

30-minute classes with individual guidance in and around the water. Working at their own pace to get more confident and efficient in the swimming world.

Private Lessons (ADULT):

45-minute classes with individual guidance. Focusing on getting those who are not confident in and around the water to a more independent water experience.

Sea Otters (AGES 6 months-3 years):

30-minute classes, including parent/child engagement! During class we will work with parents to get their younger children comfortable and confident in and around water. Working on guided discovery of the water environment while being in the caring arms of a caregiver.

Crab (AGES 3-4):

30-minute classes, smaller class size! Preschool age children will receive an introduction to water in a controlled and comfortable environment. During this class they will focus on becoming more comfortable in and around the water environment. This is for children only (not parent/child) with a small class size.

Seahorse (AGES 3-5):

These 40-minute classes are for those who are comfortable around water but not yet confident. They will work on water introduction and being in a group setting. While in a smaller class size they will have more one-on-one time with instructors.

Jellyfish (AGES 5-12):

During the 40-minute classes they will work on putting their faces in, floating with assistance, and moving through the water with assistance. They will be in water where they can touch the bottom if needed.

Stingray (AGES 5-12):

40-minute classes for children who can float and feel comfortable with their faces in the water but are still working on making independent forward progress. Working toward water that is over their head.

Squid (AGES 5-12):

40-minute classes working toward building their stamina. Introduction to longer distances along with deeper water.

Octopus (AGES 5-12):

40-minute classes introducing more swim strokes. While working in deep water they will start exploring strokes while increasing their distance.

Dolphin (AGES 5-12):

40-minute classes with children who are able to swim 25 yards while performing rhythmic breathing. Taking place in deep water they will work on refining their strokes while increasing the distance they can swim efficiently.

GET OUT AND EXPLORE **VICTOR'S PARKS**



AUBURN TRAIL

This improved trail has a stonedust surface, which is suitable for hiking, running, biking, snowshoeing, and cross-country skiing. The trail is approximately ten miles in length and connects to the Towns of Pittsford and Farmington. There are convenient parking areas located at various road crossings. Your journey on the Auburn Trail will take you to Powder Mill Park to the west and Mertensia Park to the east, across a bridge over Irondequoit Creek, through a tunnel adorned with colorful murals and to many connector trails into Lehigh Crossing Park and along the Seneca Trail.

BOUGHTON PARK

[Stirnie Road & Boughton Road](#)

Located in the Town of East Bloomfield, Boughton Park is owned by Victor, East Bloomfield, and West Bloomfield. Run by an independent Board of Directors with representation from all three towns, the park covers 330 acres with 56 acres of ponds. Permits for the park can be obtained at Victor Town Clerks office, 85 East Main Street. Please bring proof of residency (NYS ID and car registration). The permits are free to Victor Residents.

DRYER ROAD PARK

[7405 Dryer Road](#)

This park is a regional attraction and destination for mountain biking and trail use which also features a bike park including a pump track and jump line. The park has two natural surface soccer and lacrosse fields, an artificial turf box rink, year-round restrooms, picnic shelter, large children's playground and two-hundred vehicle parking area. The park plays host to a variety of community events including summer concerts, bike festivals, tournaments and sports league play. Future plans include an asphalt or concrete pump track and skate park, additional athletic fields, and expanded parking to the south.

FISHERS PARK

[7929 Main Street, Fishers](#)

Victor's oldest, dedicated park contains five miles of looping trails that lead through wooded hillsides, through diverse wetland areas, and meander along the banks of Irondequoit Creek. At the main park entrance there is a picnic area with a recently completed stream bank stabilization project that increases the park's attraction as a top-class fishing destination! On the eastern side of the park there are four permanent pickleball courts and a tennis court with a large parking area. The park also has a year-round restroom located at the outdoor courts and a seasonal restroom facility in the picnic area. Future plans include an outdoor classroom / natural adventure play area.

LEHIGH CROSSING PARK

[7350 State Route 251](#)

This park offers a very diverse environment with a large network of multiuse trails and opportunities to view wildlife. The park is connected to the Auburn and Lehigh Valley rail trails as well as the Trolley Trail and Dryer Road Park connector and has a seasonal restroom facility. A fishing pond is centrally located within the park and numerous amphibians, waterfowl and birds call this park their home. Future plans include an outdoor classroom / nature education area and new fishing dock.

ENJOY AND EXPERIENCE **VICTOR'S PARKS**



LEHIGH VALLEY TRAIL

This improved trail has a stonedust surface, which is suitable for hiking, running, biking, snowshoeing and cross-country skiing. The Town's portion of the former Lehigh Valley Railroad corridor is approximately two miles in length and travels from the Auburn Trail Connection at Phillips Road to the Victor-Mendon town line. There are convenient parking areas located at road crossings. Your travels along the Lehigh Valley Trail will take you into Lehigh Crossing Park to the east and the Victor Recreation Center and Fishers Park to the west. Other notable trail connections on the Lehigh Valley Trail include links to the Domine Trail and the Auburn Trail.

MARYFRANCES BLUEBIRD HAVEN

235 County Route 9

Fondly referred to as Victor's living classroom, Mary Frances Bluebird Haven's focus is on highlighting New York's official bird, the bluebird! The main trail that loops the perimeter of the park allows visitors to view bluebirds in their natural habitat along with various other species that reside in this passive park. Secondary mown trails weave through lush meadows and open spaces where nesting boxes can be seen. Mary Frances Bluebird Haven also has a cottage available for rentals and a fishing pond with an accessible fishing dock. The park also plays host to a community garden with fourteen plots available for planting your seasonal vegetables or flowers. Future plans include a trail connection to Village on the Park, an outdoor classroom, picnic shelter, and landscaping to complement the existing terrain.

VICTOR MUNICIPAL PARK

6680 Paparone Drive, off of Brace Road

Located on 47-acres within the Village of Victor, this community park includes an enclosed lodge, year-round restrooms, picnic shelter, fishing pond with accessible dock, large children's playground, trails and beach volleyball court. The park's bandshell and amphitheater play host to the Sid Partington Summer Concert in the Park series. A multiuse trail system offers connections to the Jacob's Landing and Dorchester Park neighborhoods and is bikeable and walkable from the nearby Auburn Trail. Future plans include a spray park / splash pad and outdoor court space.



LOVE VICTOR'S PARKS

VILLAGE ON THE PARK

This neighborhood park, which is located off of County Road 9, has several areas for public use. The northern portion of the park includes a large open meadow, multiuse trails, a sledding hill with a connection to the "Helen's Way" trail and a small parking area at the County Road 9 trailhead. The central park includes a children's playground, picnic area and a small parking area. Two small-sided soccer fields, a large parking area and a seasonal restroom facility can be found at the park's south section. Future plans include additional soccer and lacrosse fields, a trail connection to Mary Frances Bluebird Haven, year-round restrooms and a new pavilion.

HARLAN FISHER PARK

With its location in the Village of Victor, this neighborhood park features a children's playground, picnic area, off-leash dog park (completed in 2024) and small parking area. The park has trail connections to Ambassador Drive and East Parkway. Dog Park passes can be obtained through the Town Clerk's office for a nominal, annual fee. Future plans include an expanded parking area and entrance drive, adventure play area / outdoor classroom, sidewalk connection to the Victorwood neighborhood and additional landscaping to celebrate this park's wonderful existing tree diversity.

PAPARONE PARK

(currently undeveloped)

The 16-acre parcel was acquired by the Town in 2005 and while it is not currently developed, the existing master plan for the park includes provisions for a community recreation center, athletic fields, pickleball courts, a picnic area and pavilion, and an outdoor classroom with wetland education stations and an adventure play area! The park also boasts the potential for bicycle and pedestrian connectivity to Victor Municipal Park (located on the west side of Brace Road) and to the Auburn Trail (located to the south).

MEAD SQUARE PARK

Mead Square Park is a small Village Park that provides respite to residents and visitors of our community. Linked to West Main Street through a curvilinear path, Mead Square offers opportunities for a casual lunch or reading a book which can be obtained from the nearby Library. There are several benches and flower gardens located throughout the park. Future plans could include expanding the park limits for event space, additional off-street parking and pedestrian and bicycle connectivity to local businesses, neighborhoods and community gathering spaces.
