Do not register before December 15.

JUMP START YOUR APPLICATION

Did you know that there are steps you can take to enhance your application that may improve your chances of being selected for a scholarship? Each award is different and focuses on unique student attributes, ranging from academic excellence, to community service, to individual activities and interests. Take the time review prior year scholarships to gain intelligence about the factors that may give you an edge.

Prep in advance:

- Turn in community service hours before the end of the first semester so they are included on your transcript.
- Draft your student essay and fine-tune it when you apply.
- Let your mentors know you plan to ask for a reference so they have them ready during the application period.
- Participate in clubs and student activities.
