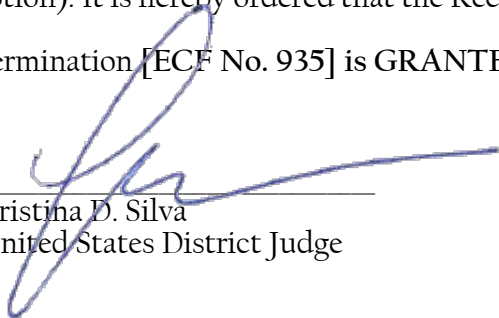

**Order Granting the Receiver's Unopposed
Motion to Approve Notice of Adverse
Claim**

[ECF No. 935]

On July 7, 2026, I held a hearing regarding the Receiver's motion to approve settlement with Wells Fargo. Mot., ECF No. 886. At the conclusion of the hearing, I advised that I would consider the Receiver's motion to approve notice of adverse claim determination. ECF No. 935. Upon review of that motion and the supporting documents, I find good cause to grant the Receiver's motion. Moreover, more than 14 days have passed since the filing of the motion, and no objections or oppositions to the Receiver's motion have been filed. *See* Local Rule 7-2(d) (explaining that the failure of an opposing party to file points and authorities in response to any motion constitutes consent to granting the motion). It is hereby ordered that the Receiver's motion to approve notice of adverse claim determination [ECF No. 935] is GRANTED.
