MESSAGE TO OUR SPONSORS & INVESTORS REGARDING COVID-19

With health and safety being our number one priority, we wanted to let you know that the Richmond Roadrunners Women's Basketball Organization has been closely monitoring developments regarding the ongoing spread of COVID-19 (coronavirus), and the impact on our staff, players, sponsors, investors and partners, as well as fans and organizational activities.

Considering the current health crisis and climate surrounding COVID-19 we will continue to monitor this matter and make the necessary adjustments to ensure the health and safety of the members of our organization as well as those in our local and surrounding communities.

The Richmond Roadrunners are closely monitoring reports from the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and have been in constant communication with our league's (The WPBA) commissioner regarding the contingency plan. They are holding weekly conference calls with all the owners providing updated information as news develops. Here is a summary of our contingency plan thus far:

WPBA CONTINGENCY PLAN AS OF APRIL 5, 2020:

Continuity of Operations Objectives

The objective of the Women's Professional Basketball Association (WPBA) COVID-19 Contingency Plan (COVID-19 CP) is to ensure the continuation of operations in a way that is efficient and beneficial for the marketability of the league and its teams.

The WPBA season was scheduled to begin on May 16, 2020.

Due to COVID-19, operations have slowed and/or stalled. Most significant is the pursuit of league and team sponsorship/partnerships. As a result, the WPBA must recalculate based on the best interest of the league and its teams.

2020 season

- *Regardless of when the COVID-19 pandemic ends, 2020 will now be the WPBA's Introductory Season, beginning on or after June 1st.*
- *The 2020 season will consist of:*
 - *Community focused activities geared towards the setbacks and/or inconveniences faced by the community as a result of COVID-19*
 - *Jamborees to begin no later than July 11, 2020 in four to six of the eight WPBA cities*
 - *The WPBA All Star game to be held in Toledo, OH (TBA)*
 - *Post COVID-19 community-based events and activities*
 - *The planning and execution of WPBA specific events*

2021 will be the WPBA Inaugural Season.
