

# All Saints Covenant Church Fall Solemn Assembly & Fast

**October 20-22, 2025 - 6:00 AM - 6:00 PM Daily**

## Fasting Guidelines

**Duration:** 12 hours daily (6 AM - 6 PM)

**Type:** Abstain from food; plenty of water is encouraged

**Break Fast:** Each evening at 6 PM with a *light, healthy meal*

*Medical Note: If you have health concerns, consult your physician or modify as needed*

## DAY 1 – MONDAY, OCTOBER 20<sup>th</sup>

### **Prayer Focus: The Health of Our Church**

**Theme:** Spiritual Vitality, Unity, and Holiness

#### Opening Prayer

*“Lord, we gather as Your people, humbling ourselves before You. Search our hearts, renew our spirits, and restore the health of Your church. Let All Saints Covenant Church be a place where Your presence dwells richly.”*

#### **Supporting Scriptures:**

- 2 Chronicles 7:14 - “If my people, who are called by my name, will humble themselves and pray and seek my face and turn from their wicked ways, then I will hear from heaven, and I will forgive their sin and will heal their land.”
- Ephesians 4:15-16 - “Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of him who is the head, that is, Christ. From him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work.”
- Psalm 133:1 - “How good and pleasant it is when God’s people live together in unity!”
- 1 Peter 2:9 - “But you are a chosen people, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, God’s special possession, that you may declare the praises of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light.”

### Prayer Points:

- **Spiritual Health** - Pray for a fresh outpouring of the Holy Spirit upon our congregation. Ask God to revive our passion for worship, prayer, and His Word.
- **Leadership** - Intercede for pastoral leadership and church leaders. Pray for wisdom, discernment, strength, and protection over their lives and families.
- **Unity and Love** - Ask God to bind us together in genuine love. Pray against division, gossip, and discord. Pray for reconciliation where relationships are strained.
- **Personal Holiness** - Confess any personal and corporate sin. Ask God to purify our hearts and help us walk in righteousness.
- **Family Health** - Pray for the families in our church—for strong marriages, godly parenting, and children who love the Lord.
- **Emotional and Physical Health** - Lift up those struggling with illness, anxiety, depression, or grief. Ask for God's healing and comfort.

## DAY 2 – TUESDAY, OCTOBER 21<sup>st</sup>

### Prayer Focus: Community Impact & Evangelism

Theme: Reaching the Springdale Community with the Gospel

#### Opening Prayer

*"Father, open our eyes to see the harvest field before us. Give us hearts of compassion for our neighbors in Springdale. Embolden us to share the good news of Jesus Christ with courage and love."*

### Supporting Scriptures

- **Matthew 9:37-38** - "Then he said to his disciples, 'The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field.'"
- **Acts 1:8** - "But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth."
- **Matthew 5:14-16** - "You are the light of the world. A town built on a hill cannot be hidden... let your light shine before others, that they may see your good deeds and glorify your Father in heaven."

- Romans 10:14-15 - “How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them?”

#### **Prayer Points:**

- **Spiritual Awakening** - Pray for God to move powerfully in Springdale. Ask Him to prepare hearts to receive the gospel and draw people to salvation.
- **Bold Witness** - Ask God to remove fear and give us supernatural boldness to share our faith with neighbors, coworkers, friends, and family.
- **Community Needs** - Pray for the practical needs in Springdale—poverty, addiction, broken families, crime. Ask God to use our church as agents of transformation.
- **Outreach Opportunities** - Pray for creative and effective outreach strategies. Ask God to open doors for community events, service projects, and relationship-building.
- **Evangelistic Anointing** - Pray that God would raise up evangelists within our congregation who will lead others to Christ with passion and clarity.
- **Divine Appointments** - Ask the Lord to orchestrate divine encounters where we can share the hope of Jesus with those who are seeking.

## **DAY 3 – WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 22<sup>nd</sup>**

### **Prayer Focus: Ministry Growth & Laborers**

**Theme: Numerical Growth and Faithful Workers**

#### **Opening Prayer**

*“Lord of the Harvest, we ask You to expand Your kingdom through All Saints Covenant Church. Send us faithful believers who will serve alongside us. Grow our numbers for Your glory, and raise up workers for every area of ministry.”*

#### **Supporting Scriptures:**

- Acts 2:47 - “And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.”
- 1 Corinthians 3:6-7 - “I planted the seed, Apollos watered it, but God has been making it grow. So neither the one who plants nor the one who waters is anything, but only God, who makes things grow.”
- Psalm 127:1 - “Unless the LORD builds the house, the builders labor in vain.”

- Colossians 3:23-24 - “Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for human masters... It is the Lord Christ you are serving.”
- Isaiah 6:8 - “Then I heard the voice of the Lord saying, ‘Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?’ And I said, ‘Here am I. Send me!’”

#### **Prayer Points:**

- **Numerical Growth** - Ask God to add to our congregation daily those who are being saved. Pray for healthy, sustainable growth that honors Him.
- **Faithful Laborers** - Pray that God would send committed believers to All Saints who will serve faithfully in children’s ministry, worship, hospitality, administration, outreach, and other areas of need.
- **Gift Discovery** - Pray that members would discover and use their spiritual gifts. Ask God to stir up passion for service within our congregation.
- **Leadership Development** - Ask God to raise up new leaders from within. Pray for mentorship relationships and leadership training opportunities.
- **Resources and Provision** - Pray for financial provision to support ministry growth. Ask God to supply everything needed for expansion—space, equipment, and resources.
- **Kingdom Mindset** - Pray against selfish ambition. Ask that our growth would be for God’s glory alone and that we would remain humble and dependent on Him.
- **Retention and Discipleship** - Pray not just for new members, but for deep roots. Ask God to help us disciple and nurture every person who comes through our doors.

#### **Closing Encouragement**

“The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.” - James 5:16 (KJV)

As you commit these three days to fasting and prayer, remember that God hears you. He is faithful to answer according to His perfect will. Expect breakthrough. Anticipate His move.

And may **All Saints Covenant Church** emerge from this solemn assembly **refreshed, renewed, and ready** for all God has in store.
