LIES MY FATHER TOLD ME

“Trudeau's housing plan won't stop money laundering from fuelling housing prices.” by Dione Francis

“Ruinous high property prices have hurt the middle class and made Canadians among the world's most indebted consumers due to high mortgages.”

In August 2021 a report came out entitled “Acres of Money Laundering” It was published by Global Financial Integrity (GFI) in Washington DC. Today's new word “snow washing” the flow of billions of dollars of dirty money into Canadian real estate. Since 2015 Ottawa (Justin) has ignored the recommendations made by GIF and FATF (Financial Action Task Force). GIF's report analyzed 35 cases involving US\$626.3 million in laundered funds. (2019 report by the RCMP estimated that C\$46.7 billion was laundered in Canada in 2018 alone.)

The laundered money came from drug traffickers 58.5%, foreign origins China 22.85%, USA 11.4%, Republic of Congo 8.5% the rest divided amongst Chad, Mexico, Columbia, Malaysia, Russia and Libya. The enablers were: 22.8% lawyers, 14.2% real estate agents, 11.4% real estate development companies with the balance among financial institutions, crypto currency outfits, property managers, accountants, and mortgage brokers. What are they buying? 88% residential, 20% commercial and 5% agricultural in Canada.

The USA is doing something about the global money laundering scourge. Trudeau encourages it. The Canadian government gets tax dollars and skylines in Vancouver and Toronto all built to house laundered money. It appears to me that they know Who, Where and What's going on. I propose legal action and seize the \$46.7 CDN billion. It boils down to just a signature and someone saying; “Do it”. This brings us to the topic of CRA. Being a small business and being self employed I want all of you to know we are not rich and if asked I would say do not start a business. It's like a time share 4.5 million people own a time share 4 million are trying to get out of the contract. Don't buy a time share.

Today is Print day – Not A Trivial Matter

I have finished the copy for Day One Two and Three and picked up the negative film. I do it old school, strip the film to a aluminum plate, burn the image into the plate with a Mercury Bulb for 80 seconds, develop the plate, Gum with Arabic Gum, punch register holes at one end of the plate, bend the plate, then place it on the print cylinder of the press. Add ink black for one side blue on the other side. Black and blue represents that we are badly broken and bruised. Next I web a 200 lb roll of paper through the press, add compressed air to the press, put on my safety glasses and ear protection press go and let it RIP. Three hours later I have 30,000 flyers/ news paper/ and my printed platform ready for distribution.

Talking about print on paper. Print was the number one employer worldwide for over 50 years until the government regulated, over taxed, recycling came along, governments banned cigarette hard packs, resulting in the paper mills closing. Then along came Trivial Pursuit.

The game was released in 1981 – Northern plastics of Elroy Wisconsin produced 30 million plastic game pieces for Trivial Pursuit between 1983 and 1985. That's just the game pieces they were then collated with a dice and placed in a printed zip lock bag. In December 1993 Trivial Pursuit was entered into the "Games Hall of Fame".

By 2014 one hundred million games had been sold in 26 Countries and 17 Languages. Any idea as to total revenue? 100 million x \$ 29.00 each = **US\$ 2.9 Billion dollars in retail sales.** What about the tax dollars the governments got for doing nothing?

Any idea as to how many man hours of work was generated by Trivial Pursuit? Let's see; there was the playing pieces, dice, printed bag, the rule sheet, the game board with a printed label and black paper board cover on 85 point chip inner. Then you have the 1,000 cards printed, collated, cut and boxed into two set up boxes. Also there was a base tray with a wrap die cut . You take all those components set an assembly

line, place all the items into another set up box, assembly (which requires 8-10 people), add the plastic wrapper then put through a shrink tunnel and pack 10 games into shipping cartons then place 30 cartons on a wooden skid. 100,000,000 games divided by 300 game per skid equals 333,333 skids.

I once asked a psychologist. What's going on in our food chain? Her answer was : (We feed off of each other, everyone is somehow connected to each other, and we feed off of each other.)

My guess 10-15 million man hours to assemble and distribute plus 1.6 billion man hours playing the game.

Conclusion: Whoever engineered Trivial Pursuit deserves a medal and a standing ovation, or a pat on the back, or maybe just a simple thank you .

Look at the complexity of the game. The first 1500 games the pieces were too tight and wouldn't come out of the pie. The first 50 million games were manufactured in Mississauga. What is the real story? How did it begin? Why was it so successful? How did they do it?

Let's start with E. Joseph Cossman from California. A teacher and conductor of sales seminars. (*See Wikipedia*) Joseph did a seminar in Montreal in 1979 where Scott Abbott and Chris Haney attended.

Joseph also did a seminar in 1983 in Toronto where Gord Elliott attended. During that seminar Joseph talked about the intricacy/complexity, and creativity that went into the game. He said "I wish that I had invented that game." He never knew that both Chris and Scott were Cossman Graduates and using his crappy photo copy book Joseph sold, they actually created Trivial Pursuit. The rest is history!

Joseph was one of the few men to teach a man to fish. KUDOS to you Joseph.

Joseph passed away in Dec 7, 2002 age 84.

Chris Haney passed away in May 31 2010 age 59

Chris and Scott (posing as reporters) attended a Montreal toy fair (1980) there they met Jerry Rowan and Jerry sent them to me.

Now we have to go to a small town called Edgar, Ontario where you will find RCAF STATION EDGAR, it was part of the Pinetree Line of radar stations about 20 km (12 miles) northeast of Barrie.

See Wikipedia RCAF STATION EDGAR read it then go back and tap NEW WORD “Deinstitutionalisation”

Note: The Ontario government purchased the base for \$ 218,225 in 1964 (John Roberts PC 1961-1971) and used it as an Adult Occupational Centre for developmentally disabled (politically correct way of saying Down Syndrome) and handicapped adults and closed the centre in 1999 (Mike Harris PC 1995-2002). The Base, I would call it a very small town or village had 84 residences (houses or cabins). Two office buildings, a swimming pool, bowling alley, baseball diamond, hospital, church, and a school. BJ was a very good hard worker and eventually went to college and graduated in computer tech. BJ now has a very well paying position with one of the cell phone companies. He got married owns a house a car and lives a normal life. What a treat having BJ as a close family friend.

Jerry would inspect and quality control the finished products I would talk with the gang and get the latest low downs and latest jokes. The best time was Christmas (remember Christmas) when dress up was in the air. Why am I telling you this? I would guess that there were 50 to 60 residents and 3 to 5 staff members. The larger percentage were down syndrome adults. All shapes, all sizes, different

ethnics. It was one large family of friends with similar challenges and no worries about tomorrow. All year long they assembled toys for you know who and they knew that they were special because of you know who. That is how they viewed it until 1999 when Mike Harris (PC 1995-2002), to save money, but it was self supporting. Maybe it was cancelled for not paying minimum wage only Mike Harris knows why it was closed down “Deinstitutionalisation” was the word of the day. At a stroke of a pen they lost their friends, their hope their dreams and their family. So who got the land – it was promised to the Indigenous Peoples, of course they didn’t get it. Again messed up or corrupt politics at its best.

From 1964 to 1999 a lot of toys came from Edgar not China. I remember the plastic cups and saucers, tea sets, and dolls for the little girls.
