

What is CAMP SERTOMA for Deaf and Hard of Hearing Children?

Camp Sertoma for Deaf and Hard of Hearing Children is a coed camp for youth ages 8-16 who are Deaf, hard of hearing, use a cochlear implant or are signing CODA.

Camp week includes two age groups with special camp activities designed for fun and learning. In 2026, Camp Sertoma returns to Millstone 4-H Center in the heart of the Sandhills Gamelands, for our seventh year there.

Sertoma Clubs and Sertoma members in North Carolina, Virginia and Maryland provide the volunteer leadership and support for the week of Camp Sertoma for Deaf and Hard of Hearing Children each year.

Millstone 4-H Center is accredited by the American Camping Association. Regular summer staff members are responsible for Camp Sertoma's program content, in cooperation with extra signing staff during the week. Adult/Child Ratio for Camp Sertoma is 1:3.

HOW TO REGISTER ...

STEP 1:

Return the application, along with a **required \$50 deposit** to reserve a spot at Camp Sertoma. We accept checks, credit cards and debit cards. **You may also apply online.**

****PLEASE NOTE:** Register **by April 1** for an **early bird discount** of \$50 off the regular camp tuition rate.

STEP 2:

Once we receive the application and \$50 deposit, we will evaluate your child's registration and notify you of his/her acceptance.

****PLEASE NOTE:** *Camp Sertoma uses a priority registration for Deaf/HH campers* — Deaf/HH camper applications will be reviewed upon receipt; hearing CODA applications will be placed on a waiting list and reviewed beginning April 1. Apply today, as space is limited!

Once acceptance is granted, a **set of forms** will be sent to you, preferably via email, for you to **complete and return by June 1**. You will also receive a packing list for camp.

STEP 3:

If any **tuition monies** are due, submit via regular mail or online **by June 1**.

****PLEASE NOTE:** Regular tuition is \$575 per camper. If you register by April 1, you will receive a \$50 discount, plus your \$50 deposit will be applied to that total; with the remaining \$475 due by June 1. If you apply for camp between Apr 1 and May 1, pay your \$50 deposit when you apply, and the remaining \$525 is due by June 1.

OUR MISSION ...

Camp Sertoma for Deaf and Hard of Hearing Children gives Deaf and hard of hearing youth an opportunity to meet and associate with others like themselves, as well as interact with positive adult role models who are Deaf, hard of hearing or hearing in a fun, safe 4-H camp environment.

Camp Sertoma serves children ages 8-16 with any type of hearing loss, communication mode, or assistive listening technology. We also accept applications from CODA children (hearing Children Of a Deaf Adult, or Siblings of a Deaf Child), as long as the hearing CODA camper is able to fluently communicate using American Sign Language.

PLEASE NOTE: A *priority registration will be used for Deaf/HH campers*. This registration modification will help ensure that a balance of Deaf, hard of hearing, and hearing CODA campers is maintained at each age level — which helps us plan for staffing and activities to make sure your camper has the best access to camp. Deaf/HH camper applications will be reviewed immediately upon receipt; hearing CODA applications will be placed on a waiting list and reviewed beginning April 1. Apply today, space is limited!



CAMP SCHOLARSHIPS are available to qualified families who are unable to pay the total cost of a camp experience. If you wish to apply for a full or partial scholarship for this child, submit the scholarship application along with the camp application.

ADDITIONAL 2026 CAMP SERTOMA INFORMATION:

- COVID vaccines are *not* required to attend 2026 Camp Sertoma. However, ***all*** campers and staff must complete a health history form prior to arriving at camp. As part of the health history form, ***each camper must have a camp physical prior to attending camp. Deadline for submitting camper paperwork is June 1.***
- **Camp Sertoma adheres to a strict Code of Conduct**, which is intended to foster a safe environment conducive to optimal learning/growth. Campers are expected to behave in a way that respects the rights/property of others.
- We are optimistic that we will be able to welcome our full camp family back to Camp Sertoma this summer. We and our partners at Millstone 4-H Camp aim to ensure the health, safety and well-being of our campers, their families and staff. We will keep you informed of any developments related to safety protocols.

***A Camp Scholarship is also sometimes referred to as Tuition Assistance, Financial Aid or a Campership.**

Please note that full tuition for the 2026 camp is \$575 per camper. If you have paid the application fee of \$50, the maximum scholarship you can apply for is \$525 per camper. Scholarships can only be used to assist with tuition fees and cannot be granted to cover camp store purchases.

Supplementary financial assistance is granted based on the information provided. Please be advised that there is no guarantee that if a camp scholarship is offered, that it will be in the full amount requested. Each application will be reviewed individually, and parents/guardians will be contacted accordingly.

CAMP SERTOMA FINANCIAL INFORMATION & POLICIES

REGISTRATION & CAMP TUITION FEES

Camp tuition covers most direct costs such as food, program supplies, supplementary health and accident insurance, and camp counselor salaries. Indirect costs such as planning and administering the program are costs subsidized by the Camp Sertoma Committee.

- ⇒ **\$50 deposit**— required for each camper to reserve a spot at camp. Your \$50 deposit will be applied toward camp tuition fees & must accompany all applications.
- ⇒ **\$525** per camper for applications received **by April 1** (includes \$50 early bird discount).
- ⇒ **\$575** per camper for applications received **between April 1 and May 1**.

CAMP SERTOMA REFUND POLICY

Camp Deposits

Deposits are nonrefundable, except in these instances:

- ⇒ If, during the application process, your child is found to not be eligible to attend Camp Sertoma, your deposit will be refunded.
- ⇒ For first-time campers/families—if, after attending the May 3 Camp Open House, you decide camp is not for you, we will refund your deposit. *Written notification must be made within one week of the Open House.*

Camp Tuition

Our staff and volunteers spend significant time and money planning camp programming months prior to the start of camp. Prompt cancellation notification allows time to make necessary adjustments.

If you find that your camper can no longer attend Camp Sertoma, please notify the camp registration coordinator as early as possible.

- ⇒ A full refund will be provided if Camp Sertoma is canceled by the Camp Sertoma planning committee due to insufficient registration, acts of nature, or other reasons beyond its control.
- ⇒ In the event that a registered camper has a family emergency or is sick, a written refund request must be made no later than 10 business days after the start of camp date to receive a refund in the amount of fees paid less any nonrefundable deposit.

EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES

Have fun at camp and get paid too! Camp Sertoma for Deaf and Hard of Hearing Children is hiring signing staff for our weeklong camp. Positions include cabin counselors (both Deaf and hearing) and interpreters. Camp staff must be at least 18 and have a high school diploma. Staff members receive a salary, meals, housing and training.

Financial Assistance for Camp Sertoma

Financial assistance in the form of “camp scholarships” enables campers to enjoy the camp experience, making camp more affordable to our campers and their families.

Camp scholarships are available to campers who are unable to pay the total cost of a camp experience. You may complete the camp scholarship form online or complete the form on the next page.

A camper must be fully registered for Camp Sertoma to be considered for a camp scholarship. **Camp scholarship applications are due by May 1—to allow sufficient time to review applications.** Please note: Families may apply for assistance, not to exceed \$525 per camper.
