Age Requirement: Children must be five years old **before** September 1, 2025 to register for Kindergarten.

Documents that are REQUIRED to be presented at the time of registration:

- Child's original birth certificate (to be presented on or by 5th day of school)
- Custody Papers, if applicable
- Health Records
 - Dental
 - Physical
 - Updated Immunization Records
- IEP's or information regarding any special needs and/or accommodations

The Pennsylvania State Health Law requires each child entering school for the first time to have the following immunizations before school begins:

- 4 Doses of Tetanus, Diphtheria, and acellular Pertussis (1 dose on or after the 4th birthday)
- 4 Doses of Polio (4th dose on or after 4th birthday and at least 6 months after previous dose given)
- 2 doses of Measles, Mumps, Rubella (usually given as MMR)
- 3 doses of Hepatitis B
- 2 doses of Varicella (chickenpox) or evidence of immunity
- Children will need a physical *before* entering Kindergarten.

Registration Process

What parents can expect:

- Tours upon request
- Enrollment online, packets also available in school office, or by mail
- **Information regarding Tuition assistance (deadline to apply for assistance is *June 15, 2025*)**
- Schedule a Kindergarten Screening (if currently a HKCS preschool student this automatically will be done)

Orientation - August

In August (about one week prior to the start of Kindergarten), there will be an orientation that will allow children and their parents to meet the child's teacher. The teacher will present to both children and their parents for about 15-30 minutes in their classroom. Parents are welcome to take their child to visit the playground any time after school or after the orientation.
