Scholarship Application Information

The Raleigh-Wake Chapter of the NORTH CAROLINA CENTRAL UNIVERSITY ALUMNI ASSOCIATION, Inc.'s scholarship is open to Wake County high school seniors who have been admitted to NCCU. Scholarships will be awarded to qualifying incoming freshman students. As part of the scholarship application process, each scholarship finalist will be interviewed by members of the scholarship committee. Scholarship recipients will be notified by May 2023. Recipients must submit a photograph of themselves for use in print announcements and are required to attend the scholarship awards reception that will be held the evening of Thursday, May 25, 2023. Failure to comply with these requirements can result in scholarship forfeiture. Awards will be disbursed once enrollment is verified. This is not a renewable scholarship.

Important! Applicants must submit a mailed (hard copy) packet and an electronic (e-mail) packet to the above addresses.

A complete application packet includes:

- **A typed, completed, and signed (written signature/pen to paper) application**
- **An official copy of high school transcript**
- **A copy of SAT/ACT test scores (Not required by university, but enhances chance of being awarded a scholarship)**
- **A copy of your NCCU acceptance letter**
- **A letter of recommendation from a school official (e.g., principal, counselor, teacher, coach etc.)**
- **A letter of recommendation from a non-relative (e.g., church/community leader, employer, NCCU alum)**

NOTE: Mailed application packets must bear a postmark dated no later than **April 7, 2023**. The e-mailed application packets must be received no later than **11:59 p.m.** on the deadline. **Late and incomplete application packets will not be considered.** Handwritten applications, resumes and brochure attachments will not be considered. All responses must be typed and properly formatted. All applicants will receive a confirmation of receipt of their scholarship application packets. Scholarship finalists will be contacted by NCCU Raleigh-Wake Chapter Scholarship Committee to schedule an interview.
