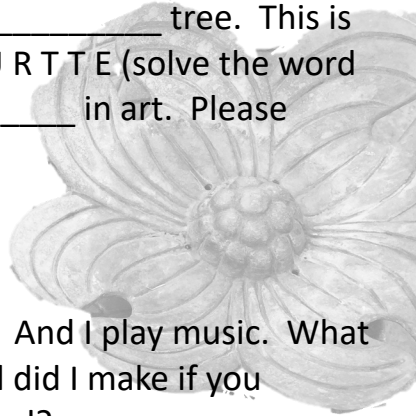
### SCAVENGER HUNT
