## Message from the President

Dear Society Members,

It is all coming together and it's now time to do your part to make this Celebration a really memorable and well-run event. We 'need' our members to sign-up to help for Tashmoo Days. We have 'lots' of jobs. Come work for a few hours and have some fun in the process. The team will also need assistance on the days leading-up to Tashmoo Days. On July 14, 15 and 16 the final clean-up of the Marina and move-in of equipment will be underway. *“Having a Good Time at Tashmoo”*

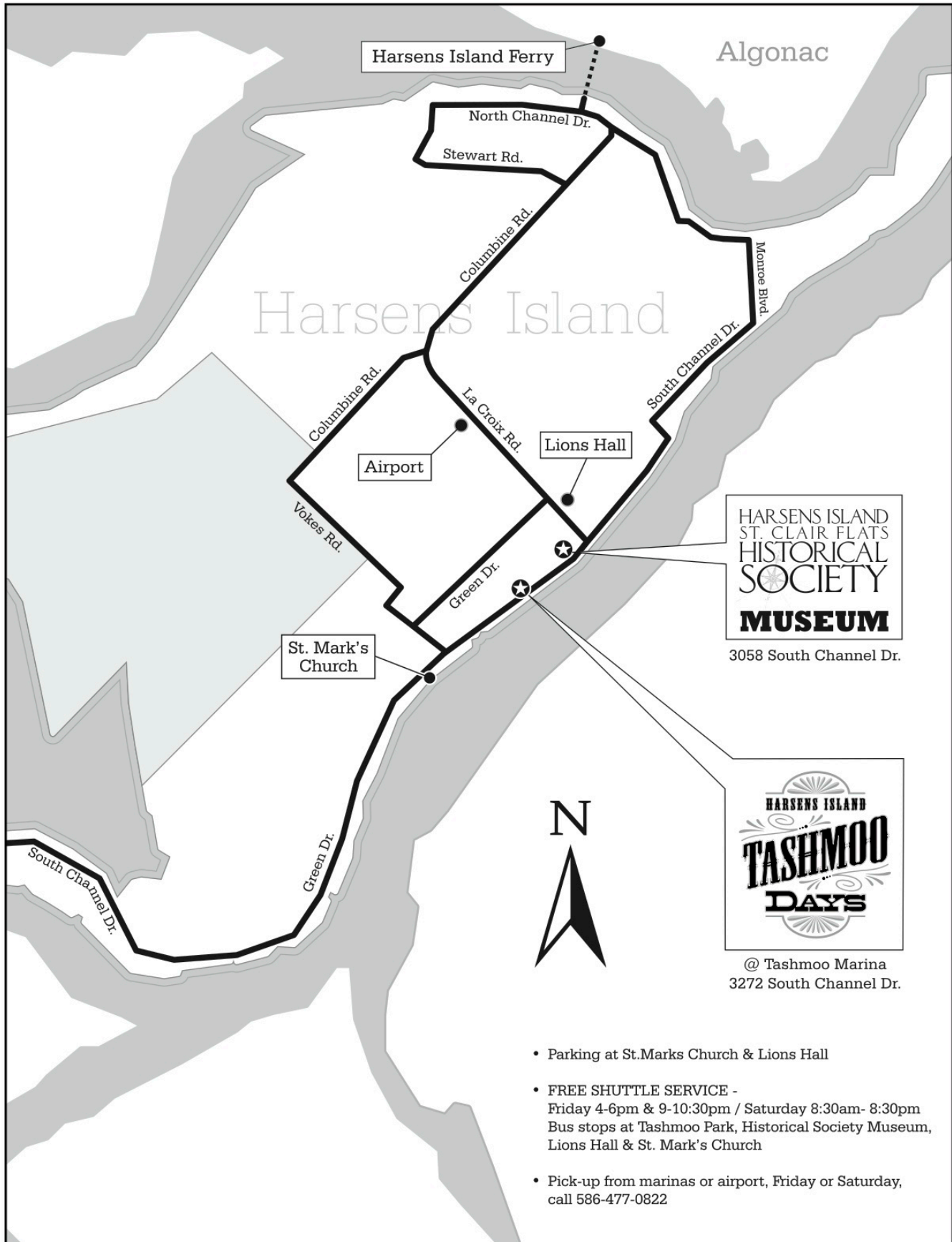
