### LOOKING FORWARD TO OUR JUNE SPEAKERS PROGRAM!



In 1950, young Judy Jessup and her family moved from Washington, D.C, to Harsens Island. They lived on a small dairy farm on Stewart Road. She graduated from the Algonac Community Schools in 1955. Bill Smith was was raised on Harsens Island and attended the Harsens Island Elementary School, Grades K-6. He graduated from Algonac High School in 1958.
