Please be advised that pursuant to MCL 168.659 Freeland Community School District voters who do in-person vote at Frankenlust Township Precinct 1, LFA Hall, 2323 Amelith Rd. are designated to vote at Kochville Township Precinct 1. Kochville Township Veterans Hall, 3265 Kochville Rd., Saginaw, MI 48604 for the Tuesday May 7, 2024 Special Election.

If you completed an Absentee Ballot Application earlier this year for all of the 2024 elections and indicated that you wanted a ballot for the Freeland School Millage in May 2024 you will automatically be sent a ballot. For anyone else, an Absentee Ballot is available for all elections; registered voters may contact Frankenlust Township Clerk, Debbie Fisher, to obtain an application for an absent voter ballot. All Saginaw and Bay County qualified electors of the Freeland Community School District have the right to mark a ballot and deposit the ballot in the Saginaw County Early Vote Center tabulator beginning the second Saturday before an election and ending the Sunday before the election from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. and on the Wednesday prior to the election from 11:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. The Saginaw County Early Voting Center is located at 618 Cass St. Saginaw, MI 48602 and is open to all qualified electors of the Freeland Community School District.

The following is the proposal that will appear on the ballot: Freeland Community School District Bond Proposal

Shall Freeland Community School District, Saginaw, Midland and Bay Counties, Michigan, borrow the sum of not to exceed Twenty-Nine Million Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$29,800,000) and issue its general obligation unlimited tax bonds therefor for the purpose of:

erecting, completing, remodeling, and equipping and re-equipping school buildings, additions to school buildings and facilities; furnishing and refurnishing school buildings and facilities; and preparing, developing, improving and equipping the Falcon Stadium complex, structures, facilities and sites?

The estimated millage that will be levied for the proposed bonds in 2024 is 3.65 mills (\$3.65 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation). The maximum number of years the bonds may be outstanding, exclusive of any refunding, is twenty (20) years. The estimated simple average annual millage anticipated to be required to retire this bond debt is 3.14 mills (\$3.14 on each \$1,000 of taxable valuation).

The school district does not expect to borrow from the State to pay debt service on the bonds. The total amount of qualified bonds currently outstanding is \$0. The total amount of qualified loans currently outstanding is \$0. The estimated computed millage rate may change based on changes in certain circumstances.

(Pursuant to State law, expenditure of bond proceeds must be audited and the proceeds cannot be used for repair or maintenance costs, teacher, administrator or employee salaries, or other operating expenses.)
