You need to contact the Zoning Administrator if you are contemplating building or replacing:

- a shed over 100 square feet in floor area
- a fence
- a deck
- a driveway
- an addition to an existing structure
- a swimming pool
- a garage
- a pole barn
- any other accessory structure
- any building project

The Township requires zoning and building permits for these improvements to verify that state construction code and local zoning ordinance requirements have been met.
