The Frankenlust Township Planning Commission will hold two (2) public hearings on Wednesday, May 19, 2021 at 7:00 p.m. in the Township Hall Board Room at 2401 Delta Road, Bay City, MI 48706 by authority of the Michigan Zoning Enabling Act (Public Act 110 of 2006, as amended, MCL 125.3101 et seq.) to invite public comment on the following proposals:

- 1. A hearing on an application from Serv-A-Pure Co. for Planned Unit Development (PUD) Area Plan and rezoning approval on 6.25 acres of land (parcel #030-011-400-190-00) on the west side of Westside Saginaw Road (M-84) between 6750 and 6860 Westside Saginaw Road, approximately 0.75 miles south of Delta Road and immediately north of the Consumers Energy high voltage transmission line in the SE¼ of Section 11.
 - If approved, the PUD Area Plan would authorize the site to be used for the water purification company's new headquarters, including warehouse, office, light assembly, service, and retail showroom activities; and also to be available for future service, storage, technical training, laboratory, research, retail, and workshop studio uses.
- 2. A hearing on proposed amendments to Section 3.07 (Accessory Structures) of Zoning Ordinance No. 79 to clarify the requirements for an attached accessory structure and to update the detached residential accessory structure standards.
